Dr. Man explains the causes of Androgenetic alopecia, or hereditary hair loss. Dr. Man pointed out that prior to the introduction of the HairMax LaserComb there were only 2 drugs for men and only 1 for women available for treating hair loss. HairMax provides the first available non-drug treatment option. He explains that HairMax works by utilizing laser energy to stimulate hair growth through the process of PhotoBioStimulation. This process increases energy within the follicle and increases

blood flow, bringing more oxygen and nutrients into the hair follicle. This increase in cellular energy and blood flow extends the growth phase of the hair, revitalizes dormant hair follicles, reverses the thinning process and encourages new hair growth which is denser, fuller and stronger.

In the interview, Dr. Man emphasized that the device has been proven in numerous clinical studies to be a safe and effective non-drug treatment for hair loss.
