The step-by-step guidelines in the installation instructions are a general reference for installing a Swiss Madison Sink. Should there be any discrepancies, Swiss Madison cannot be held liable. It is recommended to install all Swiss Madison products by hiring a licensed professional



- 2. Confirm that your model will fit in intended location and plumbing fixtures are located where legally required before beginning installation.
- 3. These installation instructions are for solid surface, composite material countertops.
- 4. Not all drawings on this manual are drawn to scale. Please refer to the model chart.
- 5. Two people are recommended to install and move this product.

1. Determine Reveal Type

• Using scissors to cut along the line of the paper template for your desired reveal type.

Negative: Counter edge extends past sink rim approximately 1/4" (Figure A)



Positive: Sink rim is exposed approximately 1/4" from edge of countertop (Figure B)



Flush: Sink edge is flush with countertop opening (Figure C)

2. Position and Trace Template

- Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out.
- Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop.
- Trace the template onto the coutnertop.

Note: Make sure clearance is suitable for back splash, faucet, and plumbing for the sink.



3. Cut Countertop

• Cut an opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line from the template.

Notes:

- Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.
- Professional should be consulted for cutting countertop



4. Install Mounting Brackets

- Turn countertop over and align sink with countertop. Decide location for mounting brackets.
- Mounting holes should be drilled 1/2" from the edge of the sink.
- Install anchors into drilled holes and lightly tap with a hammer until flush with countertop.
- It is recommended to install faucet according to the manufacturers installation instructions at this point.



5. Secure Sink to Countertop

- Clean underside of the countertop and around cut-out area making sure area is smooth and free of defects.
- Apply a bead of sealant to the rim of the sink near the inside edge. Be careful not to miss or skip any area.
- Carefully lift sink squarely under countertop cut-out. Press firmly on sink to form seal and seal sink. Immediately wipe excess sealant with damp cloth. Be careful not to smear or spread sealant onto countertop or sink.



6. Attach Mounting Hardware

- Attach mounting hardware over the lip of bowl to secure bowl.
- Verify alignment of sink again and tighten fasteners to secure sink.
- Wipe away excess sealant with a damp cloth.
- Allow sealant to set for 45-60 minutes.





7. Installing Plumbing Fixtures

- Turn counter back over.
- Connect drain, trap to drain, and water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instruction.
- Test run water into sink and check for leaks.



Lifelong Care: Swiss Madison Stainless steel sinks are easy to maintain with minimal care. For best results, always rinse with mild soap and wipe after each use. Rub lightly with soft cloth in the direction of the drain on a regular basis. To avoid damage and discoloration to the sink surface never use steel wool, scouring pad or abrasive cleaners.
