This Eraser is the fifth version of the design. The Eraser features a drop edge design. The handle is comfortable in a variety of grip positions. The blade can be deployed either with the flipper or thumb hole. The Eraser comes in either sculpted 3D titanium with framelock or 3D sculpted bolster lock with marble carbon fiber.

It comes with a combination blade finish, 3D contour titanium handles and titanium bolster lock with a choice of carbon fiber or micarta inlays.

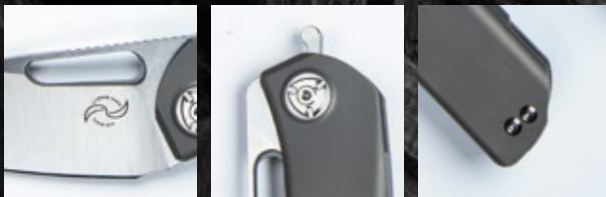

The Traveler is a small slip joint with a utility blade made of M390 steel, with a choice of full carbon fiber, micarta or titanium handles plus reversible pocket clip.

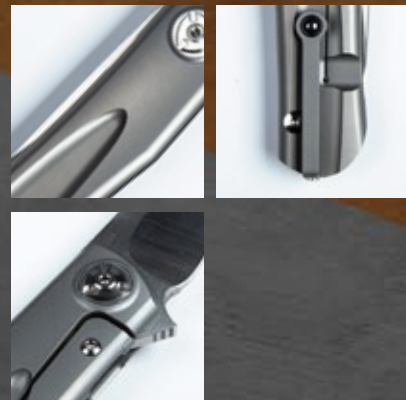

The Warrior 2v2 takes what Liong Mah liked in a traditional Japanese sword and made it into a folder. Like a Japanese sword, it features a hand ground combination blade. The main bevel is hollow ground and the tanto tip is convex ground. The Warrior 2v2 is available in titanium with 3D knurling on the handles with a choice of carbon fiber or micarta inlays.

This button lock features an American Tanto Blade grind, full 3D sculpted titanium handles with a reversible spring clip and stainless steel hardware.



10 ZULU

A smaller EDC folder inspired by a Zulu Slip Joint. The Zulu features a Bohler M390 steel, flipper opening and integral frame lock. There is also a nail nick on the blade. The titanium handles come with a choice of carbon fiber or micarta inlays. Reversible titanium spring clip completes this package.

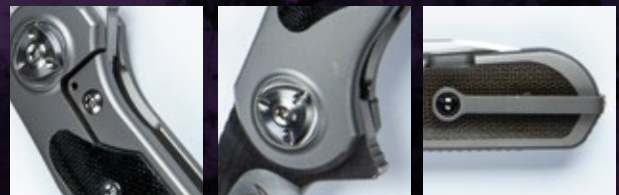

The Xenobit follows in the success of the Xeno Multitool Pry Bar. Liong Mah had requests to incorporate a blade into the utility handle. The small EDC fixed blade comes with an ambidextrous kydex knife sheath, a ball chain and paracord lanyard for neck carry.

The bottle opener is incorporated into the hole. The wrench works on hex bolts from 1/4 inch to 1/2 inch. Made from a solid billet piece of titanium.
