#### Additional Supplies Needed:

- Rubbing alcohol or a non-oil-based cleaning solution. **IMPORTANT: Do not** use bleach products

**IMPORTANT** Center "DuraBumper" logo on narrow-end of cart as shown in Figure 6.

**Fig. 1** Dirt prevents Velcro from adhering well. Thoroughly clean cart's metal frame with rubbing alcohol or a non-bleach / non-oil-based cleaning solution.

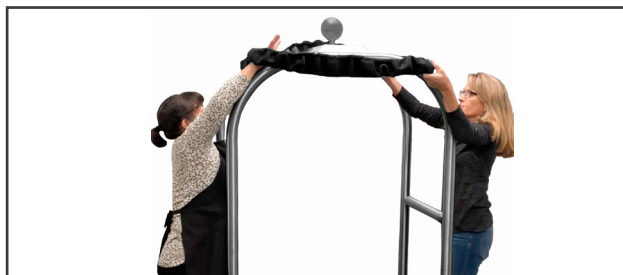

**Fig. 2** Two people are recommended for easy installation. Slip fabric bumper over cart.

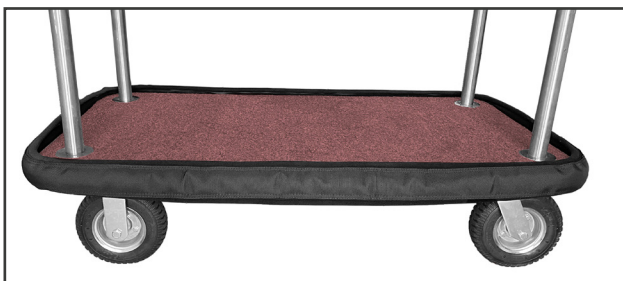

**Fig. 3** Pull bumper guard downward and stretch over cart's metal frame.

For each long-side of cart, refer to Fig. 4 and Fig. 5.

**Fig. 4** Pull bumper downward. Center and attach Velcro strip onto cart's metal frame.

**IMPORTANT** Velcro strips must be positioned along TOP-EDGE of cart's metal frame.

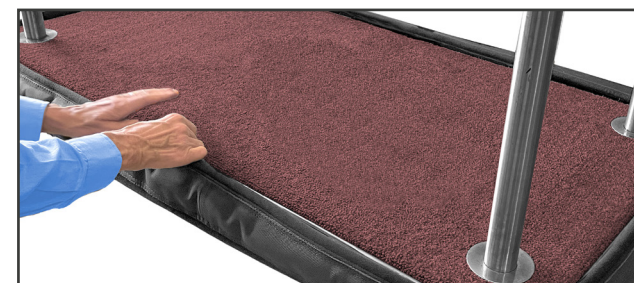
