

# **Poly Truck Bumper Guard**



Custom Fit for Poly Trucks with Hard Plastic Top-edge

☐ Rubbing alcohol or a non-oil-based cleaning solution Important: DO NOT USE BLEACH PRODUCTS

## **Step 1: Prepare Cart for Velcro Installation**

Clean Cart: Dirt and bleach products will prevent Velcro° adhesive from adhering well. Clean top-edge of Poly Truck with rubbing alcohol or a non-oil-based cleaning solution.

## **Step 2: Bumper Guard Installation**





- Fig 2.1 Installation process begins on narrow-end of cart. Attach the two 3-inch Velcro adhesive strips along top-edge of cart as shown above.
- Fig 2.2 Center "DuraBumper" logo on narrow-end of cart. Attach bumper guard onto Velcro and press firmly into place. The remaining portion of bumper should rest inside cart.

- Fig 2.3 Slip bumper guard over top-edge of cart.
- Fig 2.4 Beginning on long-side of cart (Side A):
  - a. Pull bumper BELOW top-edge of cart, exposing two corners.
  - b. Attach Velcro strips along cart's top-edge as follows:
    - □ 24-inch Velcro on long-side of cart
    - □ 6-inch Velcro on remaining narrow-end (Side A only)
    - □ 2-inch Velcro on the two exposed corners

## **Step 2: Bumper Guard Installation (continued)**

Fig 2.5 Beginning at a corner:

- a. Pull bumper guard up and over corner and align top-edge of bumper with Velcro.
- b. Stretch and pull bumper toward opposite end of cart and attach bumper guard to Velcro on second corner.
- c. Once bumper is attached to corners, pull bumper guard up and over cart's long-side and align bumper with Velcro's top-edge.

Fig 2.6 Press bumper securely into place.

Preform Steps 2.4a through 2.6 for Side B

## **Bumper Guard Installation Complete**



**Extend the Life of Bumper Guard** 

As corners of bumper begin to wear over time, gradually rotate bumper around cart.
