Installation Instructions

Fig. 1: Turn bumper guard inside-out. Insert wide end of bumper into trash can.

Fig. 2: Bumper guard alignment:
a. Align seam of bumper guard (red outline) with top-edge of trash can.
b. Align triangular cutout with trash can's handles (yellow lines).
c. Peel plastic backing from pre-installed Velcro® and attach bumper guard to inside wall of trash can.

Fig. 3: Once secured, roll bumper onto trash can, covering handle with narrow-end of triangle. Bumper should not cover handle-hooks (circled in yellow).

Fig. 4: As illustrated with yellow line, align bumper's seam with top-edge of trash can.

Fig. 5: Accessory Installation:
a. Trash bags install over bumper guard. Secure plastic bag onto trash can's handle-hooks.
Note: For best results, use 55-gallon or larger plastic bags.
b. Attach caddy-pockets to each side of bumper guard.

Fig. 6: Fill caddy-pockets with cleaning supplies.

Care Instructions

Bumper Guard: Machine wash in cold water. While still damp, re-install bumper on trash can to air dry.

Caddy-Pockets: Remove cleaning supplies from caddy-pockets. Spray pockets with antibacterial cleaner and wipe thoroughly with a damp cloth.
