The quintessence of Central Otago Pinot Noir - powerful and seductive.

Hand-reared on the North-facing slopes of Bendigo, one of the warmer sub-regions in Central Otago, the semi-continental climate and free-draining silt and gravel soils produce vivid and concentrated flavours.

This is a wine with broad shoulders yet soft hands that have laid out a fruit feast. You will be greeted with black cherry, red plum and vanilla bean on the nose. Ripe boysenberry and cream flavours adorn a rich and rounded mid-palate that finishes with subtle notes of cocoa and cloves.

The oak is restrained, and the tannins assert their presence but are soft and inviting. A complex fruit bomb with a serious demeanour and silky, svelte structure.

A wine that truly screams more!

Harvest Method	Hand-picked.
Processing	100% destemmed and cold soaked for several days prior to fermentation.
Fermentation	Fermented with indigenous yeasts. Fermentation was managed by cap plunging for the gentle extraction of colour and tannin, followed by post-ferment maceration for further tannin integration.
Maturation	11 months in French oak barriques (approx. 25% new).
