Correction Sheet

Night Owl & Early Bird

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You will need **7/8 yard** of the beige or brown for the center foundation, pieced borders, and outermost border. This is enough for **one** quilt. NOTE: For the pieced border, your 1-1/4" strips really only need to be a little over 16", so if you only purchased 3/4 yd., cut the 17" x 35" center background piece first, cutting across the full width of the fabric, then cut 4 of the 1-1/4" strips from the 5" or 6" of fabric remaining.

Cut **1-1/2" strips** for the outermost borders from the beige or brown used for the center foundation & pieced borders. You will need **two pieces 1-1/2" x 23-1/2"** for the ends and **two pieces 1-1/2" x 39-1/2"** for the sides.

Tangled Threads

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For the button flower stem, cut a bias strip 1" x 15". Fold this in thirds, wrong sides together, and baste down the center.

When stitching it to the quilt top, place the side with the raw edge against the foundation and stitch it in place.

Little Red Bird

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From the gray fabric, you **do not** need to cut a 5-1/4" square.

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
