PUMPKINS ON THE TABLE

Supplies: (page 35)

You will need **1-1/4 yd.** cream pumpkin print for background.

You will need a **fat eighth (10" x 18")** of the cream print for the inner star points.

In the instructions for the Center Star Block, the 7th point down, the gold and brown triangle units in Diagram 5 should be squared up to $13\text{-}3/4"$ x **$11\text{-}1/2"$** . Because of this, the 4 squares from the cream pumpkin print for the corners should be cut $11\text{-}1/2"$.

AUGUST STARS

Page 7: For the Ohio Star Blocks, you only need to cut **20** squares $3\text{-}1/4"$ x $3\text{-}1/4"$, not 40.

HINTS OF FALL

Page 13: For the prairie point borders, you need to cut 2 strips $2\text{-}1/4"$ x $31"$ and 2 strips $2\text{-}1/4"$ x **$15\text{-}1/2"$** from the tan for the outer border.

ROW OF GOURDS

Page 15: For the pieced border, you will need to cut **5** squares $4\text{-}1/4"$ from the medium brown and **6** squares $4\text{-}1/4"$ from the gray.
