If you are interested in learning about making wine, apply for one of our harvest intern positions. This is a great introduction if you are considering entering the wine industry, having worked harvest qualifies you for a variety of positions in the industry including working in tasting rooms, marketing, winemaking/cellar work and other positions. Or, if you just want to experience harvest, it is both lots of fun & lots of work.

- -Weekly salary, \$900-1,000/week, amount depends on prior experience. Work is 6 days/week, same day off every week. Full sit-down lunch served daily, with great wines opened, including special library wines.
- -We are a small winery where interns will directly participate in all facets of the winemaking process while working closely with the winemaker & assistant winemaker.
- -Hours can be long and vary from 8 12 hour days.
- -Must be able to lift 75 pounds, be on your feet all day, working often in wet conditions.
- -Harvest is both hard work and we have fun, please be prepared for both if you apply. Prior experience working harvest, and forklift skills are pluses but are not required.

- o Winery and equipment sanitation
- o Complying with safety requirements
