4th Century AR Stater Obv Pegasus



Corinthia within Greece

CORINTHIA. Corinth. Ca. 375-300 BC. AR stater (22mm, 8.55 gm, 3h). NGC Choice AU 4/5 - 4/5. Pegasus flying left; qoppa below / Head of Athena left, wearing Corinthian helmet pushed back on head, A before neck, astragalos behind. Calciati, Pegasi 400. Ravel 1039. Deeply and superbly struck in sound metal and near perfect centering. RARE this nice.



Corinthia is one of the regional units of Greece. It is part of the region of Peloponnese. It is situated around the city of Corinth, in the north-eastern part of the Peloponnese peninsula.

Additional Rarity: A LYCIA. Phaselis. Ca. 4th century BC. AR stater NGC AU 4/5 - 5/5 sold at an auction on September 7, 2017 for \$1,920.
