
## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOLKSWAGEN HEADLINING

Your new VW headlining is a one-piece conversion headlining designed to up-date and make your VW interior look like a late model VW and has been made for easy installation. There are two headlinings, one that fits the VW from 1958 to 1967, and one that fits the 1968 to 1977. The early model (1958 to 1967) has cardboard sewn on the front of the headlining. The later model (1968 to 1977) has no cardboard sewn to it. Fe sure to check your headlining against the year of your car. The only difference in the entire installation will be the removal of the windshield on the later model (1968 to 1977), the sun visor brackets and rear view mirror.


- Step 1 Remove the rear window and both rear side quarter windows, and on later model (1968-77) remove the windshield.
- Step 2 Remove the rear cushion and rear backrest.
- Step 3 Remove the courtesy straps and dome light.
- Step 4 Starting at the rear window remove the old headlining around the window opening and both rear side quarter windows. DO NOT REMOVE THE DOOR POST TRIM unless you are re-doing the door post.



Step 5 Remove the headlining from the upper door opening and across the front of the windshield.


The headlining should be free and hanging from the bows only. Slide the bows toward the front of the car and remove the headlining with the bows in the listing.

Step 6 Remove the bows from the old headlining and install them in the new headlining. See Illustration 2.




Be sure to leave the rubber tips on the ends of the bows.

Step 7 Start installation at the front of the car at the windshield, install the bows from front to rear,



see illustration 3. If your VW is the early model (1958 to 1967), use a dull putty knife to slip the cardboard over the lip. See illustration 4.



If your VW is the late model, see illustration 5. The headlining in illustration 5 is glued at the edge of the lip on the inside first and the excess is trimmed 1/2 inch away from the lip, folded back and glued on the outside of the lip. See figures A, B, C and D.
