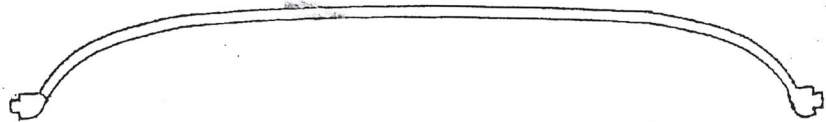

All Mini Saloons built after 1970 with wind up windows in the doors have stays to support the headlining in the roof aperture. There are six rails required and each rail is colour coded. You will see that the plastic ferrule on the end of each rail is of a different colour. Each of the differently coloured rails are of a slightly different shape to follow the contours of the roof. The correct sequence of colour coding is sketched out below. The plastic ferrules slot into holes already in the bodywork.

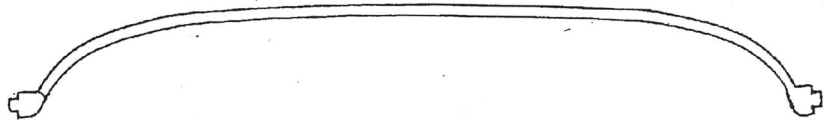
