The Pierneef Collection

This premium range is a tribute to South African artist Jacob Hendrik Pierneef (1886 – 1957), famous for his mastery in portraying the unadorned beauty of the South African landscape and its architecture. Each new release in the range reflects a different piece of Pierneef art on its label. Limited in supply, the range consists of varietal wines and innovative blends. Grapes are sourced from site-specific vineyards and organically grown vines in specific terroirs.

La Motte Pierneef Sauvignon Blanc (Organically Grown)

The grapes originate from La Motte's organic vineyards on the Nabot farm in the Walker Bay region. It is a fuller wine, un-wooded and a perfect expression of its terroir, which is enhanced by cool breezes from the nearby Indian Ocean.

Equal amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon dominate, to create the Bordeaux profile for which this wine is known. For the first time, though, Shiraz as added for more complexity and it is probably responsible for the hint of aniseed. The wine is intense on the nose, with cherry and mulberry fruit together with cinnamon spice. Wood maturation has enhanced a toffee and caramel presence. Very smooth and juicy on the palate

Shiraz

- 2000: Toffee, coffee and candy floss nose together with cardamom and fennel spice. The palate is very firm with classic leathery tannins. The wine has very good aging potential. 395
- 2002: Dried fruit, straw and leathery nose. Elegant wine with dry finish. 395
- 2003: The complex nose of perfume, coffee, leather, mushroom and little mint reflects the very good vintage for Shiraz. The palate shows juicy fruit with a fresh, dry, tight finish. A very good time to drink. 395
- 2004: On the nose there are intense black cherry and mulberry fruit integrated with cigar box, coffee, clove and cinnamon spice. The palate is muscular bodied with chewy berry fruit and lots of peppery spice between well integrated tannins. 335
- 2005: Another good vintage showing attractive red fruit such as raspberry complemented by liquorice and sweet candy flavours. A well rounded, friendly palate with a juicy finish. 280
- 2006: Developed evolution with coffee, dried fruit, black cherry and stewed plums. Very accessible and recommended for early drinking. 230
- 2007: Young but settled wine with attractive strawberry and redcurrant fruit complemented by slight mint and liquorice. A very smooth but powerful palate finish with lively dry tannins. 195
- 2008: A dominant spicy nose with clove, nutmeg and black pepper backed by mulberry fruit and some leathery tones. The palate is medium-bodied with a juicy mid-palate and a complex, layered mineral finish. 195

Millennium™

- 2001: A very good colour for an old wine. The wine and wood are integrated well to give a prominent dark chocolate character and a structured palate particularly on the back palate. A mouth filling wine. 325
- 2002: The nose shows developed evolution with dried fruit and cheesy notes. The palate is medium-bodied but lively and pleasant. Ready to drink. 325
- 2003: The wine shows plum and cherry flavours mixed with cinnamon, clove and cardamom spice. Coffee and truffle flavours can also be detected. On the palate there is a mineral presence. Lively tannins lend a pleasant after-taste. 325
- 2004: Still youthful at 6 years, with black forest fruit, dried cherry and dark chocolate. The palate is full-bodied, but the weight is well balanced with a rich consistency. 265

- 2005:** Lots of dimension, with tobacco, roasted nuts and earthy beetroot with cinnamon spice. The structure promises good aging potential while the palate finishes long and rewarding. 225
- 2006:** This vintage Millennium™ is the first to be Cabernet Franc based. The Cabernet Franc shows attractive intense dark chocolate. The five varieties blended harmoniously to reveal a smooth palate with juicy tannins. 187
- 2007:** Dominated by earthy flavours and spice on the nose with beetroot and cinnamon showing strong, followed by dried marjoram herbs. 155
- 2008:** This is the first Millennium™ to be 100% from our farm in Botrivier. The wine has a pure intensity of flavours with raspberry, plums, fruitcake, toffee and truffle prominent. 130
- 2009:** A dusty, earthy nose with raspberry and mulberry fruit, cinnamon spice and a hint of mint, promising a complex wine with developing depth and complexity with age. 130

Cabernet Sauvignon

- 2000:** Fresh-looking ruby colour. A complex nose with sweet, voluptuous juicy fruit on the nose. The palate is very soft, but the finish is dry and lively. 395
- 2003:** wine shows the spicy side of Cabernet Sauvignon with cinnamon, clove and nutmeg well integrated, with a good amount of berry fruit. The wood contributes with toffee flavours. A 3% Cabernet Franc and 3% Petit Verdot contributed to a complex palate, with layered texture and earthy flavours. A very good season for Cabernet Sauvignon. 395
- 2004:** Lots of cherry and berry fruit on the nose, integrated with cedar, toffee and cinnamon. The palate is firm with prominent tannins typical of this varietal blended with 5% juicy Merlot. The after-taste reminds of Italian herbs. 335
- 2005:** From a season which delivered good extraction and colour. The Cabernet Sauvignon is complimented with 10% Cabernet Franc. Lots of varietal characteristics with berry fruit, cedar, herbs and toffee on the nose. A firm structure with powdery tannins and a dry finish. 280
- 2006:** The intense nose shows cinnamon spice, violet, truffle and dark chocolate. It further reminds of ripe cherries and savoury caper berries. 230
- 2007:** The dark red colour and big extract reveals a great year for reds. Intense varietal nose with blackcurrants, violets, mint and slight plum. Heavy body but rounded tannins and fleshy consistency. 195
- 2008:** The blackberry fruit, followed by leafy and mint aromas, together with nutmeg and cinnamon spice reflects the varietal intensity of this wine, which include 14% Cabernet Franc. 165

Shiraz • Viognier

- 2004: The Viognier lends an exceptional gentleness to the blend - the palate is elegant and friendly with peach and cherry, blackberry and violet flavours. 498
- 2005: Similar style to the previous two vintages with 89% Shiraz and 11% Viognier. Another remarkable vintage. 415
- 2006: The wine shows intense red berry fruit with slight caramel nuances extracted from the French oak. These are well integrated with dried peach flavours. The ample-bodied palate has a powdery texture with spicy undertones and lots of dimension. 346
- 2007: The intense violet colour of this wine reflects a season that was excellent for Shiraz. Blueberry and stewed plum fruits are surrounded by pepper, clove and liquorice spices. The balance is harmonious. 288
- 2008: This vintage moves away slightly from the luscious warm fruit of previous vintages, to a linear clean fruit character with a tight juicy palate. It is intense on the nose, with black cherry and raspberry fruit, white pepper and liquorice spice. 240

This MCC is a typical Champagne colour, with a very fine lively mousse. The nose shows delicious strawberry fruit, complemented by yeasty dough and biscuit aromas.

NV Mômesolitaire WO Franschhoek 145
A good acidic backbone carries a fruit filled nose with citrus, biscuits and brioche.

Rickety Bridge Brut Rosé WO Franschhoek 168
A perfect blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir with a delicate expression of citrus and hints of wild berries. On the palate, elegant freshness combines seamlessly with cassis and finishes with finesse.

Dieu Donné Brut WO Franschhoek 170
Creamy, fresh apple and lemon elegance compliment the leesy biscuit richness, emphasized by a fine soft bubble.

NV Graham Beck Demi Sec WO Western Cape 177
"Bliss". A fine excuse for self-indulgence and frivolity. Light yeasty aromas with hints of butterscotch, honey and praline, this delectable bubbly will stimulate your sweeter senses.

Pierre Jourdan Cuvée Belle Rosé WO Coastal 195
The faintest tinge of salmon pink, a lively presentation of Pinot Noir flavours, a pleasing fine mousse which reveals an elegant dry finish.

Boschendal Grand Cuvée Brut WO Franschhoek 200
Fresh green fruit with hints of citrus, supported by nuances of classical almond biscotti.

My Wyn Garagiste WO Franschhoek 200
Elegant, fine mousse, finishing off with a lingering, creamy citrus after-taste.

NV Colmant Brut Reserve WO Western Cape 205
A subtle pale gold colour with a very clean and elegant nose. The aroma has a gentle spicy toastiness with a yeasty/lemon perfume followed by more mature fruit.

NV Morena Brut Rosé WO Franschhoek 206
Light salmon colour with dry citrus flavours. Good acidity creates a zesty mouth feel.

Stony Brook Lyle Garagiste WO Western Cape 206
Very clean and fresh with a hint of citrus and some nutty tones. The palate is rich with wonderful biscuit flavours and a long creamy finish.

Chamonix Blanc de Blanc Brut WO Franschhoek 248
Fresh citrus nose with a rich, spicy character.

White Wines:

Grapes for this wine are produced on La Motte’s Nabot organic farm in the Walker Bay coastal region. It is a fuller wine, un-wooded and a perfect expression of its terroir. 125

Leopard’s Leap WO Robertson
An elegant un-wooded wine with aromas of lime, fresh cut apple with subtle citrus undertones, elegant, well-rounded with a crisp and refreshing aftertaste. 65

La Motte – Franschoek single vineyard WO Franschoek
This wine is made from whole-bunch pressed grapes produced exclusively on La Motte and fermented in 300-litre French oak barrels. The wine has a fruity style with subtle wood. 119

Rupert & Rothschild Baroness Nadine WO Western Cape
Elegantly structured with aromas of citrus leaves and honey blossom. Clean mineral undertones with a subtle touch of nougat. 275

Chenin Blanc

Leopard’s Leap Lookout WO Perdeberg
A medium to full-bodied semi-sweet white wine with gracious grapefruit and orange zest and peach flavours joined by whiffs of candy floss and sunny mango, satisfying and lingering. 60

Mulderbosch “Steen op hout” WO Western Cape
Fruit-driven style with a powerful nose of guava, lime zest and ripe pear braced by honeysuckle and orange blossoms. Well-balanced and elegant, stylistically off-dry and lightly oaked. 96

Ken Forrester FMC WO Stellenbosch
Rich and layered with dried apricots, vanilla and honey. A true icon. 550

White Blends

Haute Cabrière Chardonnay • Pinot Noir WO Franschhoek 135
Elegant and lively fruit balance, with a slightly leading acidity. Chardonnay
Pinot Noir performs on the palate with a long-lasting finish.

De Grendel Winifred WO Durbanville 165
A blend of Semillon, Viognier and Chardonnay. Apricot, peach and tropical
citrus notes accompanied by broadness and structure.

Tokara Director's Reserve WO Stellenbosch 290
An intense blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon with undertones of passion fruit
and a slight hint of lamp oil. The oak is evident in the background as a touch of
toasted almonds and fresh buttered toast, then broadening with passion fruit,
Cape gooseberries and ginger spice, finishing with toasted almonds and brioche.

Rosé

Leopard's Leap Lookout WO Perdeberg 60
A Pinotage style that is startlingly dry and sophisticated. Beautiful pink fruit
followed by candy floss and elegant hints of cranberry and raspberry.

Delaire WO Helshoogte 80
Made from 100 percent free-run juice, this unique Provence-style Rosé is fresh and displays
flavours of cassis, ripe strawberries and dark red berries with a crisp and dry finish.

Vrede en Lust The Jess WO Paarl 80
Displays fresh strawberries, raspberry and watermelon fruit, floral notes and a smooth finish.

Other Cultivars

Terra Del Capo Pinot Grigio WO Western Cape 90
Fruity, crisp pineapple and Golden Delicious apple fragrance. These follow through on the
palate delivering a smooth, fresh mouth-feel with an integration of fruit and acidity.

Simonsig Gewürztraminer WO Stellenbosch 110
Intensely perfumed nose of litchis, rose petals supported by honey sweetness as undertone. The
rich body of the wine is well balanced with the crisp acidity which provides a long lingering finish.

Cederberg Bukettraube WO Cederberg 122
Well-balanced wine with delicate sweetness and crisp acidity. Expressed floral
aromas, hints of apricot and deep fruity flavours.

De Wetshof Riesling WO Robertson 135
A dry, yet delicate wine, abundantly complex on the nose and palate
with a typically spicy, deep fruity flavour.

Paul Cluver Riesling WO Elgin 140
A vibrant wine with intense flavours of spice and florals – especially lime
and white blossoms. The palate is lean, elegant and refined with a lingering
aftertaste due to the good acidity of the wine.

Grapes have been carefully selected from specific vineyards in different regions **149**
to capture this flagship's desired spicy, berry and violet flavours. The wine has
a firm structure promising a good maturation potential.

Ernie Els Proprietor's Syrah **WO Helderberg**
Intense blueberries, pepper ham and warm toast. Almost thick in texture, **345**
the layered finish crescendos in a sweet spice and wood-smoke ensemble.

La Motte **WO Western Cape**
An elegant, typically South African-style Cabernet, made to reflect varietal characteristics. **149**
Grapes have been hand-sorted to ensure that only ripe tannins end in the bottle.

Kleine Zalze Family Reserve **WO Stellenbosch**
On the nose this wine shows well integrated berryfruit. Following through **310**
to blackberry flavours which delivers a lingering aftertaste.

Cederberg Five Generations **WO Cederberg**
The 18 months of maturation in new French oak has intensified the rich aromas **495**
of blackcurrant and cassis, layered with decadent dark chocolate and cherry
tobacco. A lingering and velvety texture.

Cabernet Franc

Anthonij Rupert **WO Coastal**
Ethereal floral notes give way to savoury mocha spice and ripe berry fruit flavours. **640**
A lightly textured, smooth wine with dry, refined tannin and a lingering finish.

Merlot

Leopard's Leap **WO Darling Swartland**
Mushrooms and dark fruit flavours. Rich with notes of chocolate and cedar wood on the finish. **73**

Meinert **WO Devon Valley**
An appetising mix of redcurrant, mint, spice and mineral aromas. The palate **170**
is soft with a touch of firmness on the finish.

Pinotage

Diemersdal Pinotage WO Durbanville 150
Red fruits, vanilla, coffee and rich dark chocolate aromas. Full flavoured and smoothly textured with oriental spice impressions.

Beyerskloof Reserve WO Stellenbosch 182
Dark berry and plum flavours are well balanced with complex aromas from new French oak. A wine with a long and smooth finish.

Pinot Noir

De Wetshof Nature in Concert WO Robertson 345
The soft, velvety cherry and redcurrant flavours linger on the palate. Smooth tannins and added dimension through careful oak maturation make this an elegant wine.

Hamilton Russell WO Hemel-en-Aarde Valley 576
Serious and delicately powerful, perfumed mineral nose with a distinct cool climate feel.

Sangiovese

Terra Del Capo WO Coastal 115
The oak and nutmeg spice adds complexity to a lighter-style palate. Raspberry, black cherry and spice with just a hint of liquorice evident bring a lingering aftertaste.

Red Blends

Leopard's Leap Cabernet Sauvignon • Merlot WO Darling Swartland 73
Fresh aromas of blueberries, plums and cassis with hints of coffee. Elegant, round with firm tannin structure.

Gaurdian Peak Tannat • Malbec WO Western Cape 275
Complex and layered with initial nutty impressions backed by soft coffee and blueberry aromas and a delicate spicy cinnamon undertone.

Bordeaux Style Blends

La Motte Millennium™ WO Western Cape 95
Equal amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon dominate, to create the Bordeaux profile for which this wine is known. For the first time, though, Shiraz as added for more complexity and it is probably responsible for the hint of aniseed. mineral, cedar and dark berry. Full bodied with a very long well rounded finish.

Tokara Red, Director's Reserve WO Simonsberg
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec. This is an intensely 469
complex wine with high toned fruit, perfumed aromas and spice dominating the nose.
Flavours of blackcurrant, christmas cake and a hints of mint lingers on the palate.

Meerlust Rubicon WO Stellenbosch
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc deliver an intense very deep 495
youthful colour with violets, ripe plum and intense spiciness. Full bodied palate
with great persistence.

Rupert & Rothschild Baron Edmond WO Western Cape
Full rounded Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot in an earthy minerality 497
of aromas with black cherries and cranberries. Smooth and seductive finish with
dark chocolate followed by lingering tobacco notes.

Leopard's Leap SMV Family Collection WO Western Cape
A well-structured blend, typical of the Rhône style. The nose is dominated 107
by red berries and the palate is infused with espresso and dried herb flavours,
with subtle spicy undertones.

Saronsberg Full Circle WO Tulbagh
Dark and dense Shiraz, Grenache, Mourvèdre and Viognier bursts in ripe fruit 424
flavours with floral notes and undertones of spice. A soft, full-bodied and elegant
mouth feel is backed by integrated oak.

Hanneli R WO Western Cape
The combination of Shiraz , Grenache and Mourvèdre and forty eight months' 845
wood maturation has produced a wine with exceptional depth, complexity and
personality. The first impression is that of floral perfume and potpourri, combined
with the flavours of sweet stewed prunes and liquorice, backed by caramel wood
flavours. The tannins of the wood and grapes are combined, to form a highly
structured, surprisingly soft palate.

2010 Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc **Appellation Marlborough**
Scented and summery, this Sauvignon Blanc has delicious vibrant aromatics that infuse the tropical fragrance of fresh passion fruit and juicy pineapples, with garden fresh basil and the spiciness of fresh tomato leaves. **445**

2009 Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir **Appellation Marlborough**
Intensely fragrant with alluring aromas of dark plums and lifted hints of blueberry, layered over spicy sandalwood and smoky bacon. The palate is succulent and flavoursome with dark fruits and toasty oak gently supported by plush tannins. **517**

Argentina

2008 Flechas de los Andes Gran Malbec **Appellation Mendoza**
Opaque purple coloured, it reveals a brooding bouquet of cedar, espresso, violets and black cherry. It borders on opulence, with layers of succulent fruit. A smooth textured wine, spicy flavours and a lengthy finish. **299**

Germany

2010 Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt Riesling **Appellation Mosel**
The juicy, exuberant character of this Riesling invigorates the palate. Melon, litchi, and the scent of ripe, yellow grapes, fruit-filled with a pleasant acidity and a recognizable minerality. **240**

France:

2007 Château des Laurets **Appellation Puisseguin-St. Émilion**
This wine is dominated by aromas of fresh berry fruit with woody notes reminiscent of aniseed, cedar and vanilla. The palate is particularly smooth and round, a hallmark of great St. Emilion Merlot based wines. **300**

2004 Château Clarke **Appellation Listrac-Médoc**
A dense, dark ruby coloured wine that has an expressive and intense nose of blackcurrant, cherry and plum aromas with hints of mocha, smoke and spice. **405**

2001 Château Pichon Longueville,
Comtesse de Lalande Appellation Pauillac
Very deep purple colour. Some extremely ripe fruit on the nose. 2 633
Dense but with attractive, mineral notes.

2002 Château Angelus Appellation St. Émilion Grand Cru
Big smoky fruit, intense, aromatic, spicy and complex. 2 920
Rich, dense, defined on the palate.

of white fruit and a complex finish of citrus.

2009 Jean-Claude Bachelet et Fils Appellation Puligny-Montrachet
Enticing buttery tones through to nutty aromas and a crescendo 705
of racy citrus fruits. Finishing long and satisfying.

Combe aux Moines 1er Cru Appellation Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru
Louis Jadot produces a fine, elegant, full-bodied wine. It is structured and complex 830
with a deep colour, developing distinguished aromas of blackcurrants.

Intense aromas reminiscent of white flowers, blackcurrants, mint and pepper. 413
