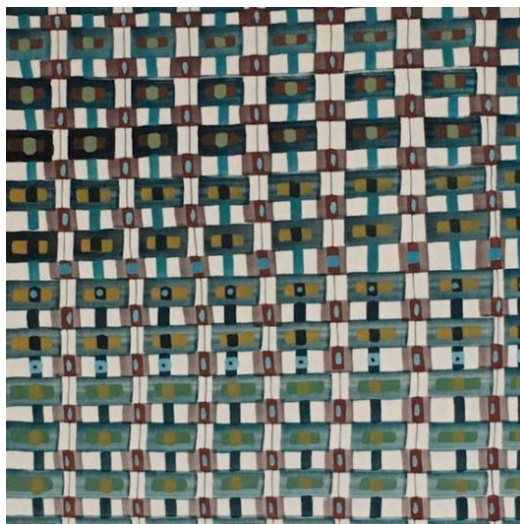


Repetition

The perfect imperfection – an exhibition of a new collection of unique works by Peter Bezuijen



Peter Bezuijen, the Dutch artist based in London and currently house-artist at The Providores and Tapa Room in Marylebone, is proud to announce the latest pop up exhibition of his most recent work *Repetition – The Perfect Imperfection*, displaying in March 2017.

This exhibition captures a concept that was created after a telephone conversation in 2015. Peter's sister rang while he was painting in his studio at home. While chatting, Peter started to draw horizontal stripes of 3 centimetres long in a repetitive pattern on the front page of The Guardian.

After finishing their conversation, he looked at what he had created: a horizontal pattern of repetitive blue 1 x 3 cm stripes. 35 rows of 9 horizontal stripes, which at first sight were perfectly positioned, but after a closer look represented *the perfect imperfection*.

The world of repetition he has created seems unlimited and full of surprises; different sizes, different shapes, different brushes, different colours and even the experiment with 3 dimensional pieces of artwork came along in the end.

The exhibition, showcasing these paintings along with printed silk scarfs, will run from 3-5 March 2017 at 16 Warner Street, London. This beautiful space has been recently renovated and will be the perfect setting for showcasing Peter's unique works.
