

Ring Sizing Guide

HOW TO USE THE RING SIZER:

We have created this printable guide to help you choose the right ring size. For the most accurate results, download the sheet then print it at 100% scale (do not stretch to fit). Please use the scaling guide below with a real physical ruler. **If the real ruler does not match the printed below, the ring will not fit properly.**



ALREADY HAVE A RING THAT FITS PERFECTLY?

Find your ring size with your own perfectly fitted ring using **the guide to the right**. Place the ring over the circles, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle closest in size. The circle diameter refers to the inside diameter of the ring. ***Please note, if you fall in between two sizes order the larger size***

LOOKING FOR A NEW FIT?

Carefully print and cut out the ring sizer below and accurately cut on the dotted line to make a slit. Slip the pointed end through the slit and gently tighten the paper sizer around your finger where you would like the ring to comfortably fit. The sizer should fit snugly (not too tight), but make sure it still fits over your knuckle. Check the band to see what number is closest to the slit. The number represents your ring size.



Common measurement questions —

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR FINGER:

Your rings should fit comfortably and securely. We recommend that you have enough room so that the ring can fit over your knuckle while still fitting securely around the bottom of your finger. We recommend measuring your finger in neutral temperature at the end of the day. Keep in mind the external room and air temperature will affect your finger — if it is warm your finger will increase in size. Don't forget to measure both hands, as your ring size can vary between your left and right hand. When using the ring comparison chart to determine size make sure the match fits perfectly **INSIDE** your ring.

IN BETWEEN TWO SIZES?

When in between two ring sizes (a half size) we recommend sizing up — please see instructions above on how to measure your finger.

DON'T USE STRING

We do not recommend using string, as it will stretch and not provide the most accurate way to determine your size. The best way is to use the paper sizer (make sure to print the guide at 100% scale and use the measuring tool to assure accuracy) or to go to a jeweler in person and get your finger measured.
