Subject: Conflict Free Material Statement for Monarch Instrument Products

This document contains Monarch Instrument's statement regarding the content of Conflict Minerals and our products. This statement is based upon information provided from our suppliers.

Monarch Instrument supports worldwide concerns that metals mined in conflict areas of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) may be making their way into the electronics supply chain. Even though Monarch Instrument is not a publicly traded company, our policy requires our suppliers to certify in writing they do not knowingly procure gold, tantalum, tungsten, cobalt, or tin from conflict areas of the DRC.

While these suppliers have stated that indeed, to their knowledge, they have provided us with conflict-free metals, we nevertheless recognize that our suppliers may have too limited insight into their supply chain to fully understand the origin of the materials.

Monarch Instrument does not knowingly use these minerals and their byproducts, as specified by the Conflict Minerals Trade Act.
