



How to Maintain Your Stainless Steel Bucket & Ladle

Your sauna bucket and ladle are manufactured of Grade 202 Stainless Steel. Sauna conditions of high heat + humidity can accelerate minor corrosion on the bucket, particularly if the surface has been scratched.

Routine cleaning after each use of your sauna bucket and ladle will keep it looking new and help preserve its corrosion resistance. Wash the bucket in warm soapy water and dry after each use. If more difficult staining exists, use a stainless steel cleaner.

Stainless steel is protected from corrosion by a thin layer of chromium oxide. Any contamination of the surface by dirt, salts from fingerprints or other material can reduce this protection. Thus, some form of routine cleaning is recommended to preserve the appearance and integrity of the surface.

The best way to prevent corrosion is to simply keep it clean and dry after each sauna use.
