

## TERRAWAGEN

## VANAGON - TRANSPORTER FENDER FLARE KIT TWFK-003

This instruction sheet is specifically for late model Vanagon and Transporters that have the large fiberglass bumpers.

## FRONT MODIFICATIONS

- 1. The front door flares only need very minor trimming at the very bottom only if you have the factory plastic air dam in place.
- 2. The rear sections of the front flare (2 small parts) have a score mark on the inside of the parts. Look carefully, the lines are very faint. These lines are there as a guide for you to cut.
- 3. Using tin snips, cut the part along the line. This is your initial cut. fine tuning is required to make the part fit YOUR van. Because every van has a different fit of the bumpers.
- 4. Use a file, or we prefer to use a Dremel with a drum sander bit. Gently file the part as you fit. It will take you a few tries to get the part to fit around the cladding. \* see picture \*



## REAR MODIFICATIONS

- 1. Similar to the front part, the rear flares have the same witness marks on the inside to show you where to trim.
- 2. Same as above, use tin snips to cut along the line but not past it. Use a file or dremel tool with a drum sander attachment to fine tune the fit until the flare can be screwed in place.
