

## TRAINER)

The ACL-600 Series is a wireless, portable jump simulation lighting system for mock door training. The standard ACL kit contains one Controller and two, four or seven Light Modules, each powered by a single CR123 battery. The systems operate on FCC approved 2.4GHz transceivers encoded prevent interference with other ACL systems in use in the immediate area.

## **TYPICAL OPERATION**

- Attach the Light Module on or near training door frame with line-of-sight visibility to trainees.
- Turn Controller and Light Modules ON by depressing the black ON/OFF pushbutton switch at the top of each device.
- The BLUE "ON" indicator should illuminate on all active devices. If the BLUE "ON" indicator does not illuminate on any device, the battery should be replaced immediately.
- Test and visually confirm that the RED, AMBER, and GREEN lights illuminate on the Light Modules when the corresponding colored pushbutton on the Controller is activated.
- Confirm that the Light Modules will not advance to AMBER or GREEN before the RED light is illuminated.
- Leave Light Modules ON, but turn Controller OFF until training commences. Light Modules should be in the "ready" condition but with lights-off.
- Turn all devices OFF by the ON/OFF pushbutton at the top of each device when training is completed. Confirm all lights and indicator are OFF.
