Where to go:

- Most trips spring of 2016 will depart from Bell Harbor Marina Pier 66 about 1/2 mile north of the Seattle Aquarium. Due to other events at Bell Harbor Marina some dates in the latter part of April may depart from other marinas, Elliott Bay, Harbor Island or Shilshole Bay Marinas. Details are being worked out.
- You must provide your own transportation.
- Note: construction has begun for the seawall/waterfront reconstruction. Traffic and parking will be affected, please plan accordingly. Visit this website for updated information on the Sea Wall Construction.

Bell Harbor Marina:

- At Bell Harbor Marina please meet a PMR staff member at the Harbor Master's Office, located behind Anthony's Restaurant.



Parking:

- Parking is available across the street along Alaskan Way in pay parking lots and garages. We do not recommend parking at a metered spot; you will likely get a ticket over the course of the 5 1/2 hour field trip.
- The nearest parking garage to Bell Harbor Marina is the Bell Street Pier Garage, with entrances on Wall St. and Elliot Ave. There is an overhead walkway at the South end of the garage that connects to Pier 66.
- School bus parking is available north of the Seattle Aquarium on the west side of Alaskan Way in front of Pier 62/63.
