You have just taken your first step in becoming a PADI Instructor with Glasgow's only PADI 5 Star Instructor Development Centre. PADI Instructor Development serves two purposes – to develop and refine both personal dive skills and leadership ability to an elevated level.

In PADI's system, instructor development begins with the PADI Assistant Instructor course through the IDC, and includes a variety of instructor enhancement programs ranging from Specialty Instructor training to IDC Staff Instructor courses.

The foundation of instructor development is the PADI Instructor Development Course (IDC), which includes online independent study through PADI eLearning or live-delivery segments. The IDC can also be separated into an Assistant Instructor (AI) course and the Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) program.

Candidates completing the Assistant Instructor course are authorized to conduct some PADI programs independently. They may also go on to complete an OWSI program in the future.

Candidates completing an entire IDC (or AIs who go on to complete an OWSI Program) are eligible to enroll in a PADI Instructor Examination (IE) conducted by PADI staff. The IE evaluates the candidate's teaching ability, dive knowledge, skill level, understanding of the PADI System, attitude and professionalism using standardized, objective criteria. When the criteria are met, candidates achieve the PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor rating.

This two phase program – the development phase (IDC) conducted by PADI Course Directors and their instructor development staff; and the evaluative phase (IE) conducted by PADI Staff – is the most comprehensive and demanding of any in the dive industry. New PADI Instructors meet the highest standards for learning and performance of any recreational diver certification organization.

PADI offers the finest Instructor training program available and the PADI IDC provides a professional learning experience in which you will learn how to teach diving using the PADI system of diver education. Enclosed you will find some important information about the courses available and their objectives.

- Proper, professional course conducted is expected at all times on professional level courses. If SCUBA DIVING SCOTLAND feel you are falling below the standard expected, you will not be able to continue with the course.
- Students are responsible for supplying all of the necessary equipment and materials for the above PADI professional courses. SCUBA DIVING SCOTLAND can provide cylinders and weights on request.
- Three passport-sized photographs must be supplied on commencement of the course.
- Towels, swimming kit etc. are not supplied by SDS, and should be brought to each session as we may arrange swim test for the same time as an academic session.
- If a student misses any of the sessions noted above additional charges may be made, at SDS's Discretion.
- If additional training sessions are required to complete the requirements of the course, additional charges will be made. Note that weather conditions are an exception to this.
- All sessions are subject to change. Times for sessions are for a rough guide only.
- Any and all course paperwork should be brought to every session, unless by prior arrangement with your instructor.
- Full payment and a signed Terms & Conditions form must be **paid 2 months prior** to the course to secure your place. However, additional students may be accepted within this time.
- Please note that all courses are subject to change or cancellation if minimum numbers are not met
- SDS accept no responsibility for personal items during the course
- All deposits and course fees are non-refundable.

•Medical Forms: I agree to obtain a medical form signed by a physician stating that I am medically fit to dive within the previous 12 months of starting any instructor course with SDS. If I intend to teach within the UK or with SDS an HSE Medical will need to be submitted to PADI for certification with the IE.

•Insurance: Appropriate diving insurance will be required by PADI to attend an IE and to certify as an instructor. I agree to have this in place before attending an IE.

•Professional behavior and attitude is expected at all times. Any behavior that is deemed to be inappropriate by SDS will result in the termination of your course without notice or refund of payment.
