



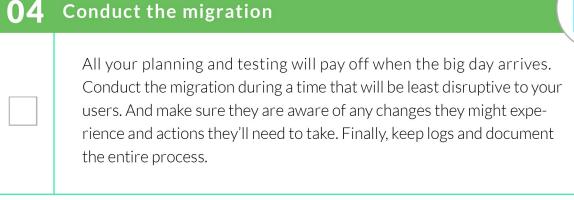

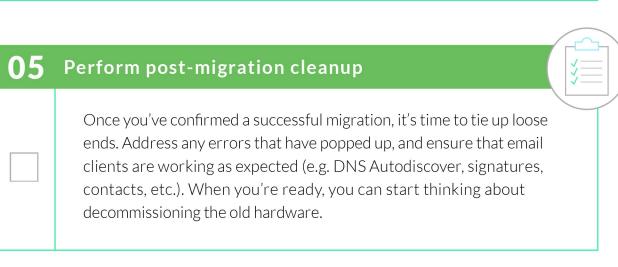
Five straightforward steps to success
