

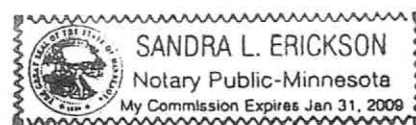

I, David Burt, the affiant do solemnly swear that the statements in this document are true.

2. **I am a professional Personal Body Trainer and holder of the Senior Mr. Minnesota 2006 Title.**
3. **I have two dogs that have been on EVOLUTION DIET since 1993. Dolly is a female Bassett Hound that is almost 19 years old. Dolly is in excellent health. Abby is a female German Shepherd that is now almost 18 years old. Both dogs are in exceptionally good health.** Dolly was born in Jul. 5th, 1988. Dolly does not get any additional supplements in her diet, although I do add some raw fresh vegetables and or vegetable juice to her Evolution Diet. Dolly still acts like a Bassett Hound dog that is about five years old and she goes for long walks on most days. She is not as frisky as Abby, but that is because she is a Bassett Hound and not in the mood to do so. Dolly now weighs about 63 lb. Dolly is not as frisky as Abby, the German Shepard.
4. Abby, my female German Shepherd was born on Jun. 10, 1989. Again, she has been on Evolution Diet Pet Food since January of 1993.
