


**AFFIDAVIT (SWORN STATEMENT) OF  
MARSHA LATKOVIC REGARDING EVOLUTION  
DIET FED DOGS THAT LIVED 17+ & 19+  
HEALTHY, HUMAN YEARS**

I, Marsha Latkovic, the affiant do solemnly swear that the statements in this document are true.

1. I live at 1205 Dutilh Rd., Suite 5, Cranberry, PA, 16066. My phone number is 724-584-7958.
2. I have had several dogs in my adult life.
3. I have used Evolution Diet Pet Food since 1989 with all my pet Schnauzer Dogs.
4. Evolution Diet is the best pet food I have ever used and I have used several other premium pet foods, but primarily Science Diet, before I used Evolution Diet.
5. My previous two Schnauzer dogs were fed Evolution Diet since 1989. One of my dogs, Scotty, lived in good health until he was over 17 human years of age. He was on Evolution Diet since 1989 and he lived until 1995 when he died at 17.5 human years of age. Scotty acted and appeared to be in good health until he died in his sleep at 17.5 years of age. Scotty was born in 1977. My other male Schnauzer Dog "Rocky" lived to over 19 human years of age and he was born in April of 1979. "Rocky" died in 1998. "Rocky" appeared to be in good health up until a few months before he died. "Rocky" was on Evolution Diet from the time he was born. Both "Rocky" and "Scotty" got additional vitamin supplements in their diets, and I did add food processor shredded raw, fresh vegetables and or vegetable juice to their Evolution Diet usually on a daily basis. I also have a male Schnauzer Dog at this time that is 8 plus years on the Evolution Diet and he is doing extremely well. The veterinarians I have seen over the past 25 years with my Schnauzer dogs told me that they usually live up to 12 to 13 years of age and then usually die from natural causes about that time.
