size approx 4.5 x 7cm (1.7 x 2.75 inches)

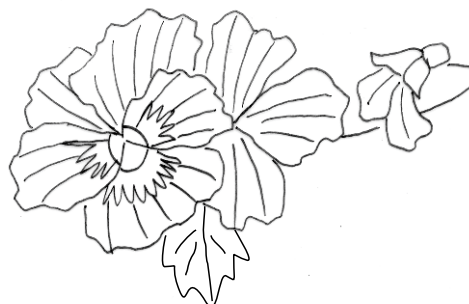
Tracing Outline actual size

Materials

- * Piece of cotton fabric size 25 x 25cm
- * Threads as per list
- * Sharps needle size 11
- * Supergrip hoop size 6/7" (17/18cm)

Preparation

- * Iron the fabric to remove creases.
- * Trace the outline provided onto the fabric.
- * Mount fabric into the hoop ensuring it is drum tight.
- * Follow the step by step directions.



Suggested Finishing

This could be used to make a needle case, pin wheel, book cover, sachet, spectacle case or any item of your choice.

Threads

Approx 15 shades of DMC stranded cotton shades are used in this design each one carefully chosen to best represent the colour in the original picture. Anchor substitutes can be used but may not provide the same tonal effect. Use one strand throughout.

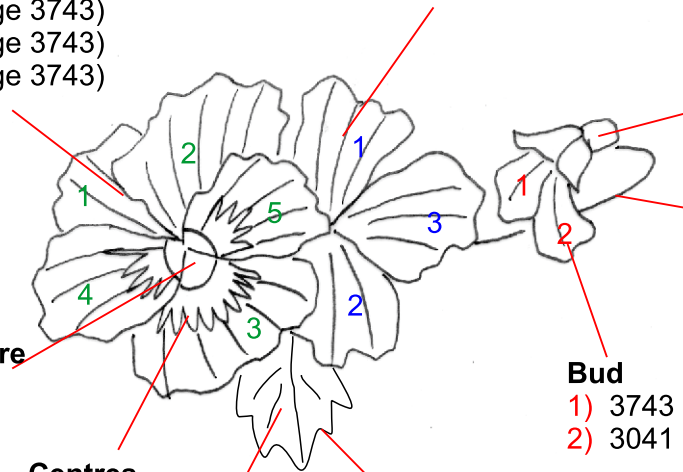

Instructions

Use the thread diagram for placement of shades and the enlarged pictures for details.

Stem

Fill the stem with adjacent rows of split stitch.

Leaf

Fill the leaf with long & short stitch on either side of the centre vein.



Bud

Outline each bud petal with split stitch. Fill each petal with long & short stitch from the base towards the sepals.



Sepals

Fill the sepals with long & short stitch.



Back Pansy

Outline each petal with split stitch. Fill each petal with long & short stitch from the outside edge in towards the centre.



Front Pansy

Outline each petal with split stitch. Fill each petal with long & short stitch from the outside edge in towards the centre. Add a few stitches on the edge in 3743.

Pansy Centre

When all the stitching is complete go back and add a few straight stitches for the dark centre. Fill the triangle with straight stitches.
