KESTREL MONTES | CALLIGRAPHY

1) small: will get the job done for uneventful mail



2) medium: a good all purpose gift size



3) large: the best for invitations and other nice mailings



4) round: a fun alternative



4) extra large: recommended for use as the "ship to" address (i.e., rsvp returns)



IN GENERAL...

1) There's no "right" size. It's more a matter of the look you want for the use you need. (However, for logo stamps, consider the shape of the logo.)

2) Each name/address will fill the space differently. Your stamp will be made with the biggest imprint possible within the given space. The pink outlines here represent the whole surface of the stamp.

STILL NOT SURE WHAT SIZE....

1) Print this sheet.
2) Cut out the samples.
3) Lay them over the envelopes you plan to use. (remember that the text doesn't necessarily fill it in all four directions depending on the name and address text).

NOTE...

- If the stamp is not available in the small size, it's because the design would not fit legibly.
- You can email your logo before ordering if you need guidance as to best fit according to logo shape.
