## Special Techniques

p.28: Long Tail Cast-On

For instance, if you want your knitting to be 10 " / 25 cm wide, leave a tail of 30 " / 76 cm plus 6 " / 15 cm for weaving in $=36 " / 91 \mathrm{~cm}$ total.

## p.29: Provisional Cast-On:

Rep steps 3-4.

p.157: MATERIALS: Yarn: The required yardage should read:

Yarn:
Yarn A: $\mathbf{8 1 5}(\mathbf{1 7 7 2}, \mathbf{8 1 5})$ yds $/ \mathbf{8 5 0}(\mathbf{1 6 2 0}, \mathbf{8 5 0}) \mathbf{m}$ of colorway 1 in lace-weight yarn.
Yarn B: $361(710,361)$ yds / $330(650,330) \mathrm{m}$ of colorway $1 ; 145(285,145)$ yds / $135(265,135) \mathrm{m}$ of colorway 2 in a different lace-weight yarn.
p.163: Crochet - only directions: Color A should be replaced by CC1.
p.197: YARN INDEX: The sample numbers, page numbers, and skein counts should read:

Sample 2 (p. 159)
Yarn A: 3 skeins of Felix by La Bien Aimée (75\% Falkland Merino, 25\% Corriedale, 710 yds / 650 m 100 g ), colorway Peach Sweater.
Yarn B: 1 skein each of Helix by La Bien Aimée (75\% Falkland Merino, 25\% Gotland, 710 yds / $650 \mathrm{~m}-$ 100 g ), colorways Peach Sweater and Lichen.
Yarn C: 1 skein each of Merino Super Sock by La Bien Aimée ( $75 \%$ Merino, $25 \%$ nylon, 467 yds / 425
$\mathrm{m}-100 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorways Peach Sweater and Lichen.
For crochet-only version
Yarn A: $2(4,2)$ skeins of Felix, colorway Peach Sweater.
Yarn B: $1(2,1)$ skeins of Helix, colorway Peach Sweater.
For knit-only version
Yarn A: $1 \mathbf{( 2 , 1 )}$ skeins of Felix, colorway Peach Sweater.
Sample 1 (p. 158)
Yarn A: $3(5,3)$ skeins of Ra-Ku Lace by mYak ( $100 \%$ Tibetan cashmere, 383 yds / $350 \mathrm{~m}-50 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Ra-ma.

Yarn B: $2(4,2)$ skeins of Baby Yak Lace by mYak ( $100 \%$ baby yak, 383 yds / $350 \mathrm{~m}-50 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Oatmeal.
Yarn C: $1(2,1)$ skeins each of Tibetan Cloud by mYak ( $100 \%$ wool, 328 yds / $300 \mathrm{~m}-100 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorways Cladonia and Wild Daisy.
For crochet-only version
Yarn B: $4(7,4)$ ) skeins of Baby Yak Lace, colorway Oatmeal.
Yarn C: $1(2,1)$ skeins of Tibetan Cloud, colorway Cladonia.

Yarn A: $2(3,2)$ skeins of Ra-Ku Lace, colorway Ra-ma.
Yarn B: $2(3,2)$ skeins of Baby Yak Lace by mYak ( $100 \%$ baby yak, 383 yds / $350 \mathrm{~m}-50 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Oatmeal.
Yarn C: $\mathbf{2}(\mathbf{4}, \mathbf{2})$ skeins each of Tibetan Cloud, colorways Cladonia and Wild Daisy.

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## BRIENNE by Brienne Moody

P.170: Pocket Opening: Next Row (RS): should end with "knit to end".

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## CONFLUENCE by Caitlyn Turowski

P.90: COLLAR: The cast-on counts should read:

CO $120(120,120,124,124)(\mathbf{1 2 4}, \mathbf{1 2 4}, \mathbf{1 2 8}, 132)$
P.91: Yoke Increases: The increase round 2 instructions for size 4 should read:

For size 4 only
Inc Rnd 2: K2, *k5, m11*, rep *-* to last 2 sts, $\mathbf{k 2}$.
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## DĀRTA by Inese Sang

P.194: YARN INDEX: Sample 2: The colorway of MC and CC1, the number of skeins, and the yarn yardage/meterage of MC should read:
MC: $\mathbf{3}(\mathbf{3}, 4,4,4)(5,5,5,5)$ skeins of Tvinni by Isager ( $100 \%$ wool, $279 \mathrm{yds} / 255 \mathrm{~m}$ per $\mathbf{5 0 g}$ ), colorway 7s.
CC1: $3(4,4,4,5)(5,5,6,6)$ skeins of Silk Mohair by Isager ( $75 \%$ super kid mohair, $25 \%$ silk, 232 yds / $212 \mathrm{~m}-25 \mathrm{~g})$, colorway 7 s .

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## GEWEEF by Karen Cronje

P.59: Vikkel Braid: Sample 2: Instructions should read:

Row 1 (RS): K1, sl1 wyif, k1, kfb, place the last of the newly made sts onto LH needle; *knit the second st on LH needle tbl without slipping stitch off needle; knit the first stitch on LH needle; slip both
stitches off needle; move last stitch on RH needle to LH needle*, rep *-* until 3 sts remain on LH needle; move the first st on LH needle to RH needle, pass the 2nd to last st on RH needle over last st on the RH needle, sl2 wyib.
P.64: Colorwork Band 1 chart

Row 19 column 22 should be a K2tog, in order to maintain the correct stitch count.
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## HARMONY by Brandi Cheyenne Harper

p.147: There is an extra k1tbl on the first buttonhole row:

Begin Making Buttonholes
Buttonhole Row (WS): K5, sl1, SM, *k to next m, SM, sl1, change to CC, k to 1 st before next m, change to MC, sl1, SM, kttl*. Rep *-* once more, k to next m, SM, sl1, MB, sl2 wyif.

## KLÄNGE by Lotta H. Löthgren

p.196: YARN INDEX: Sample 1: The yarn brand should read:

MC: 2 skeins of Fe by Sägen Yarn (70\% alpaca, 20\%silk, 10\% Cashmere, 246 yds / $225 \mathrm{~m}-100 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Ursus.
P.196: YARN INDEX: Sample 2: The yarn base, composition, skein count, and yardage/meterage of MC should read:
MC: 3 skeins of Elmer Tweed Fingering by Dimond Laine (70\% Merino, 30\% Cashmere, 200 yds / $183 \mathrm{~m}-50 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Thermal.
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## PUNKT by Julia Wilkens

P.175: FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: should read Approx. 41x 87x 63" / 105x 220x 160cm
P.196: MATERIALS: Yarn: The required yardage should read:

MC: $\mathbf{8 7 4} \mathbf{y d s} / \mathbf{8 0 0} \mathbf{m}$ of lace-weight yarn.
CC1-6: 88 yds / 80 m each of lace-weight yarn (to be held double) or fingering-weight yarn.

## P.179: Chart for M dot:

Rows 3 and 4 do not match the written instructions. Columns 2 and 9 should be grey.
P.197: YARN INDEX: Sample 1: Yarn skein count and skein weight of MC should read:

MC: 2 skeins of Glowhair by West Wool ( $72 \%$ mohair, $28 \%$ silk, 437 yds / $400 \mathrm{~m}-\mathbf{5 0} \mathrm{g}$ ), colorway Birch Tree.
P.197: YARN INDEX: Sample 1: The yarn base, composition, and colorways of CC1-2, and CC3-6 should read:
CC1-2: 1 mini-skein each of Felix by La Bien Aimée (75\% Falkland Merino, 25\% Corriedale, 178 yds / $163 \mathrm{~m}-25 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorways Fluoro Morganite and Sansa.
CC3-7: 1 mini-skein each of Helix by La Bien Aimée ( $75 \%$ Falkland Merino, 25\% Gotland, 178 yds / 163 $\mathrm{m}-25 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorways Anemone, Kokko, Quartz Fumé and Highgarden, and Sansa.
P.197: YARN INDEX: Sample 2: The skein count of MC should read:

MC: 2 skeins of Onyx by La Bien Aimée ( $70 \%$ Mohair, $30 \%$ Mulberry silk, 546 yds / $500 \mathrm{~m}-50 \mathrm{~g}$ ), colorway Sansa.
P.197: YARN INDEX: Sample 2: The yarn yardage/meterage and skein weight of CC3-7 should read:

CC3-7: 1 skein of Tvinni by Isager ( $100 \%$ wool, 279 yds / 255 m per 50 g ).

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## REFLECTED by Cecelia Campochiaro

p.195: YARN INDEX: Sample 2: The yarn base of $\mathrm{MC1}$ and CC should read:

MC1: 2 skeins of Felix by La Bien Aimée ( $75 \%$ Falkland Merino, 25\% Corriedale, 710 yds / $650 \mathrm{~m}-100$ g), colorway Lichen.

CC: 2 mini-skeins of Felix by La Bien Aimée (75\% Falkland Merino, 25\% Corriedale, 178 yds / 163 m -
25 g), colorway Fluoro Morganite.
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## MOLLIG by Anna Husemann

p. 194: YARN INDEX: Sample 2

Yarn A: C1: $2(2,2)$ skeins of Hollyhock Undertone. C2: $1(1,2)$ skeins of Hollyhock Overtone.

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## STRIES by Marie Régnier

p.153: The needle sizes in the Gauge section are swapped. It should read:

23 sts x 23 rounds on 5 mm needles with CC 1 and CC 2 held together...
18 sts x 20 rounds on 5.5 mm needles with CC1, CC2 and CC3 held together...

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## VIDEIRA by Maysa Tomikawa

p.196: YARN INDEX:

Plus for optional hood and pockets
Yarn C: an extra $\mathbf{1}(\mathbf{0}, \mathbf{0}, \mathbf{0})(0,1,1)$ skein(s), colorway The Flying Knitter.

## XIAO MAI by Layla Yang of Qing Studio

p.80: Set-up row 2 (WS): P2, k2,* p5, k2*...
P.83: Neck Shaping and Folded Collar

The stitch count at the end of this section is incorrect and should read:
[89 (96, 103, 96, 103) $(\mathbf{9 6}, \mathbf{1 0 3}, \mathbf{9 6}, \mathbf{1 1 7}) \mathrm{sts}]$
The Short Rows should start with a RS row, instead of a WS.
This does not change anything for the rows repeat. Simply follow collar instructions as they are written.

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## YU by Valerie Ng

## p.31: SPECIAL TECHNIQUES:

Binding off stitches in Stranded Herringbone pattern: the repeat starts after sl1kwise:
With RS facing and using US $8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles, sl1kwise, *hk2togtblB, psso, hk2togtblA, psso*. Rep *_* to the end of the row, break both yarns and pull the tails through the last stitch.
p. 107: Row3: Instructions should read:

Row 3: K1A leaving st on LN, hk2togtblA, [hk2togtblB, hk2togtblA] to end, sl last st. (1 st inc'd)
p.108: Left-hand Column; Right Shoulder and Right Front

Short row (WS): P1A leaving st on LN, hp2togtblB, [hp2togtblA, hp2togtblB] $4(4,5,5,5)(6,6,7,7)$
times, bring Yarn A between the needles to the back, slip next st to RN, bring Yarn A between the needles to the front, return the slipped st to LN. Turn work. [22 $(22,24,24,26)(26,28,30,32)$ sts]
Row 3 (RS): K1A dropping st off LN, hk2togtblB, [hk2togtblA, hk2togtblB] to 2 sts before end, k2togtblA leaving both sts on LN , k1B dropping st off LN , sl last st. (1 st inc'd)
For sizes - (-,-,-,5) $(6,7,8,9)$ only
Next row (RS): K1A leaving st on LN, [hk2togtblA, hk2togtblB] to 2 sts before end, hk2togtblA leaving both sts on LN, k1B dropping st off LN, sl last st. (2 sts inc'd)
p.108: Right-hand Column; Join Left and Right Fronts

For size 3 only
Next row (WS): P1tblA dropping st off LN, hp2togB, [hp2togA, hp2togB] to 2 sts before the marked st, RM, p4togA leaving last st on LN, [hp2togB, hp2togA] to end, sl last st. [- $(-, 102,-,-)(-,-,-,-)$ sts]
p.110: Right-hand Column; Left Back Shoulder

Short row (WS): P1A leaving st on LN, hp2togtblB, [hp2togtblA, hp2togtblB] $4(4,5,5,5)(6,6,7,7)$ times, bring Yarn A between the needles to the back, slip next st to RN, bring Yarn A between the needles to the front, return the slipped st to LN. Turn work. [22 $(22,24,24,26)(26,28,30,32) \mathrm{sts}]$
p.111; Left-hand Column; Left Back Shoulder

Row 3: K1A leaving st on LN, [hk2togtblA, hk2togtblB] to 2 sts before end, k2togtblA leaving both sts on LN, k1B dropping st off LN, sl last st. (2 sts inc'd)
Row 4: P1tblA leaving st on LN, [hp2togB, hp2togA] to 2 sts before end, p2togB leaving both sts on LN, p1tblA dropping st off LN, sl last st. (2 sts inc'd)
Cut both yarns. Now work as for the Front, from "FRONT BODY".
