Today's Gospel » Luke 9:22-25

Jesus said to his disciples, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." (9:23)

Today's Gospel » Luke 16:19-31

Jesus told a story about a rich man who ignored a poor man as he lay starving outside the rich man's gate. Both men died. The poor man went to heaven, and the rich man went to hell. He cried out to Father Abraham for help but was told, "Remember that, during your life, you had all good things, and this poor man had none. Now he is comforted, and you are in agony. There is nothing anyone can do for you now." (16:19-26)

Holy Thursday MARCH 28

Today's Gospel » John 13:1-15

Jesus said to his apostles, "So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet." (13:14)

TRIDUUM FACTS: HOLY THURSDAY

Two special Masses are celebrated on Holy Thursday—the Chrism Mass and the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. The Chrism Mass has traditionally been celebrated in the morning or early afternoon. At this Mass, the bishop blesses the oils that will be used in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders in parishes throughout the diocese. This Mass may also be celebrated at another time during Holy Week.

At the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, we hear the Gospel that tells us Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. The lesson for his disciples and for us is that in order to follow him, we need to serve others even when serving might be difficult or unpleasant.

The Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper also celebrates
Jesus' institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. The Eucharist
nourishes us on our journey through life. The love and grace that we
receive in the Eucharist gives us the strength to serve others as Jesus did.

There is no dismissal at the Mass of the Lord's Supper. The people leave in silence and return throughout the night for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Think of a household chore that no one likes to do, such as cleaning the bathroom. Do this chore without being asked.

Participate in the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at your parish. Afterward, spend some time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Don't fall asleep like the Apostles did!


