1 | New Life

» Pray

Great and loving God, who raised Jesus from the dead, place your joy in my heart and help me to share it with my brothers and sisters everywhere. Show me the way toward the future that I might live as you are calling me to live.

>> Act

Today I will try to offer the joy of the Risen Christ to everyone I meet.

2 | Never Alone

"I am not alone. I do not have to carry alone what in truth I could never carry alone. All the Saints of God are protecting me, sustaining me, and carrying me. And your prayers, my dear friends, your indulgence, your love, your faith, and your hope accompany me."

» Scripture

Pray for me that in proclaiming the Gospel I may speak as boldly as I ought to.

• EPHESIANS 6:20

» Pray

O God of greatness, I ask you to walk closely beside Pope Benedict XVI: protect him, sustain him, and carry him as he guides your Church. Thank you, that I, too, am accompanied by your saints and sustained by their prayers.

>> Act

I will recall today that the Holy Father depends on my prayerful support.

3 | The Next Life

"Our beloved Pope, John Paul II, crossed the threshold of the next life, entering into the mystery of God. But he did not take this step alone. Those who believe are never alone, neither in life or in death."

» Scripture

If the Spirit of God who raised Christ from death lives in you...God will also give life to your mortal body because of the Spirit. ROMANS 8:11

» Pray

Holy Spirit of God, I ask your healing touch on all who have died and especially on Pope John Paul II. Thank you for your promise of everlasting life for him and for me. Help me to follow Jesus faithfully that I may share his resurrection.

... Act

I will try to be aware today of all God's gifts to me, especially the gift of life.

4 | The Saints

"The communion of saints consists not only of the great men and women who have gone before us, but all of us. All of us belong to the communion of saints. At any moment we can call upon the saints from every age to accompany us into the glory of God. There we will be among our own and truly at home."

» Scripture

Since you belong to the Lord Jesus, we beg and urge you to live as we taught you. Then you will be pleasing to God.

1 THESSALONIANS 3:1

» Pray

God of all holy people, God of the saints, thank you for these spiritual companions who pray for me and walk with me as I make my way to you. Thank you, too, for calling me to be in their number.

>> Act

I will remember today that all people are God's people and I will show reverence and respect toward all.

5 | Clear Faith

"Have a clear faith, based on the creed of the Church, and don't let yourself be tossed and swept along by every wind of teaching. Rely not on your own ego and desires, but on God."

» Scripture

Open yourself to God's Spirit. Hold on to what is good and don't have anything to do with evil.

■ 1 THESSALONIANS 5:19

» Pray

Holy God and Creator, help me to have a clear faith by embracing the teachings of the Church with joy and hope. Help me to resist those things that keep me from becoming the person you want me to be.

>> Act

Today I will thank God often for my Catholic faith and I will try to be a good witness to it.
