

## BUELL "BLAST" LUGGAGE RACK

### General

This luggage rack fits the model year 2000 and later Buell "Blast" motorcycles. It is designed to fit on the tail section directly behind the seat.

### Installation

#### NOTE

Be sure to read and understand the following procedures before beginning installation.

#### WARNING

Luggage rack weight capacity is limited to a maximum of 7 pounds (3.2 Kg). Exceeding this capacity can adversely affect handling which could result in death or serious injury.

1. Clean tail section, located behind the seat, and wipe with the alcohol wipe. Be sure that the surface is clean and dry.
2. See Figure 2. Carefully remove paper backing from template. Place template on tail section aligning so that it is straight and centered with the front edge along the edge of the tail section.
3. Carefully remove eight cut out areas "A".
4. Following instructions on the tube, apply primer to the cut out areas of the template using the supplied cotton swab.
4. Allow the primer to dry for five minutes.
5. Remove template except for its outside edge.
6. Remove the paper liner from the foam adhesive that is applied to the bottom of the luggage rack.

#### CAUTION

Be careful to install luggage rack so that it fits inside the remaining edge of the template, because, once installed, rack cannot be removed without damaging the tail section. Buell Motorcycle Company is not responsible for luggage racks that are installed crooked or incorrectly.

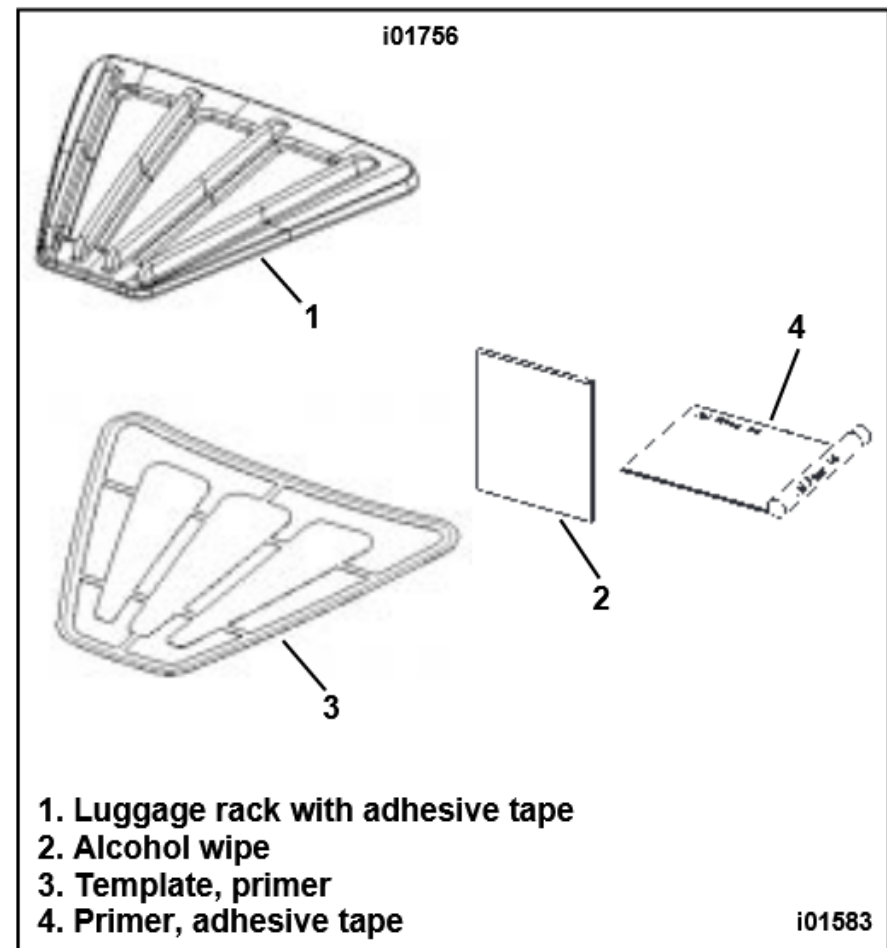


Figure 1. Luggage Rack Kit

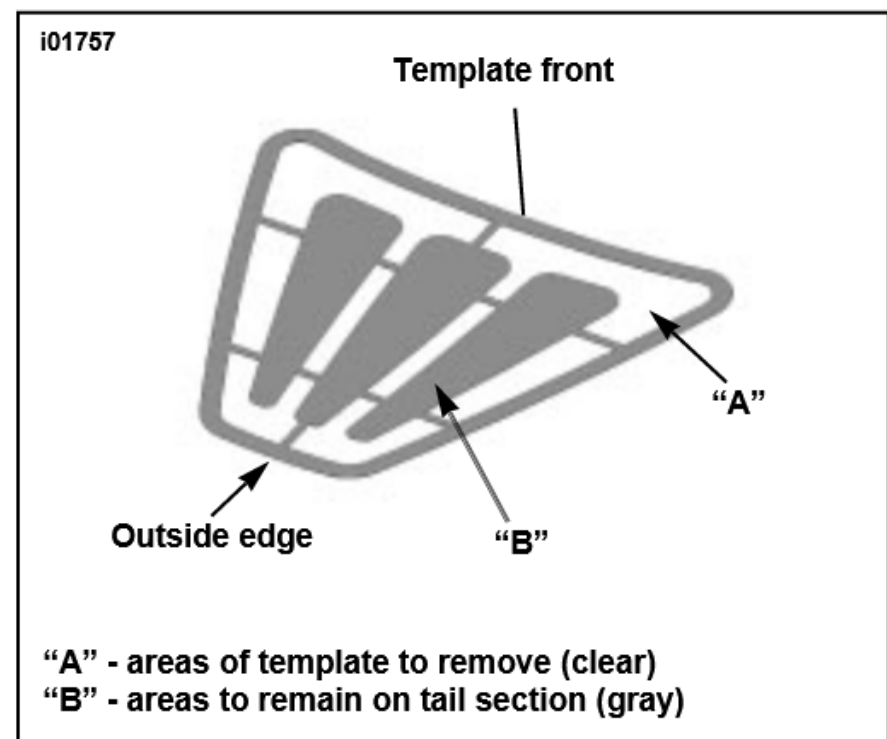


Figure 2. Template, Primer

7. Carefully position luggage rack on the tail section so that it fits inside of the remaining edge of the template.
8. Press down carefully and apply moderate pressure for at least 30 seconds. This will ensure a good bond.
9. Remove remaining outer edge of template.
