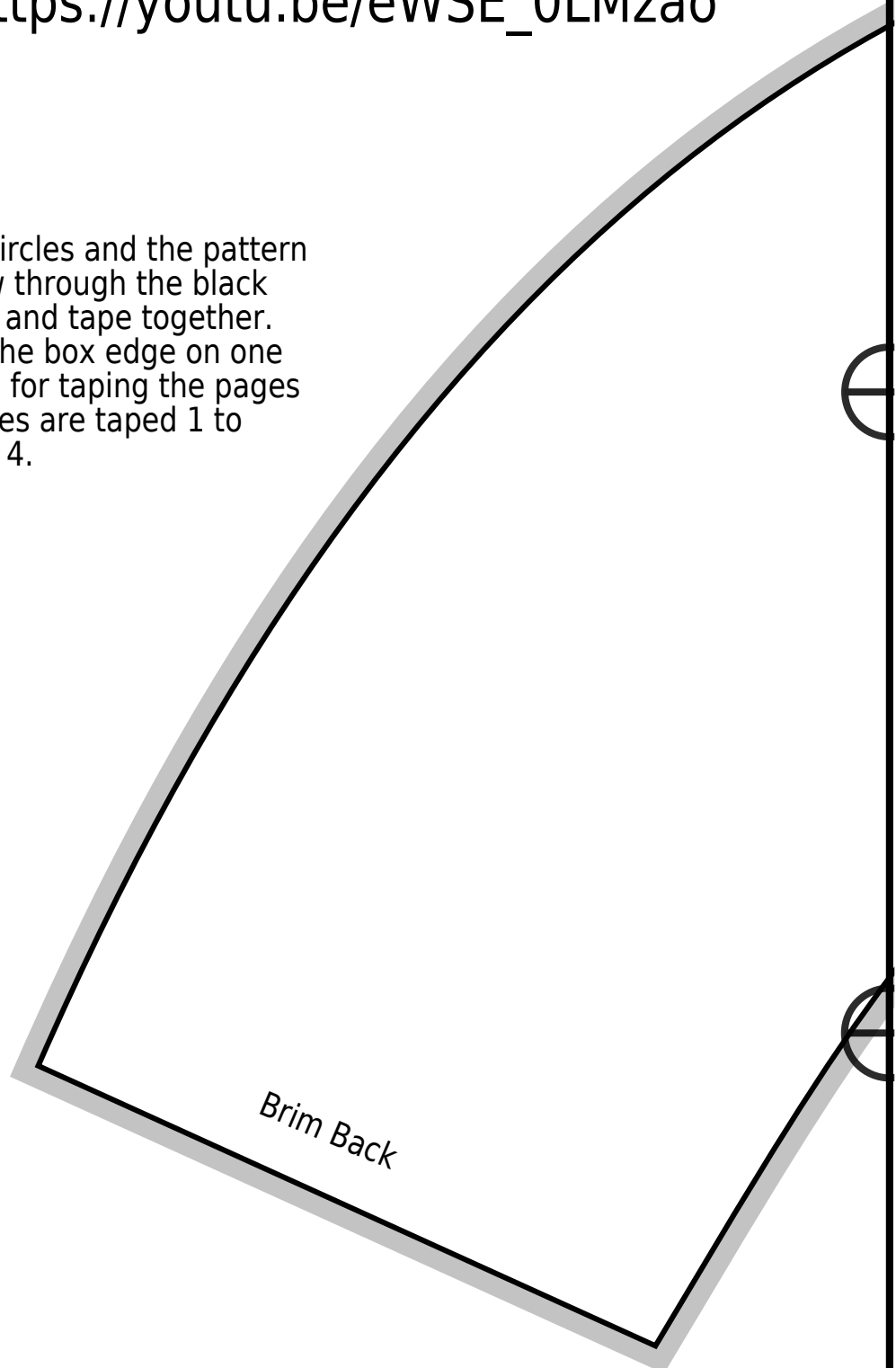

## Reversible Wide Brim Sun Hat YouTube Video and Pattern by Mad Cap Hats

Join the half circles and the pattern lines that flow through the black outline boxes and tape together. Trimming to the box edge on one side is helpful for taping the pages together. Pages are taped 1 to 2, 2 to 3, 3 to 4.

Cut 2 full pieces of fabric layer for the brim (this pattern piece is one half of the brim so cut on the fold or print out another half and tape together for a full brim pattern piece).

Cut 2 full pieces of the fusible stabilizer, one side fusible (In the video I use Medium Weight)

Optional - Cut 1 full piece of heavyweight sew-in interfacing to add to the brim layers for extra support.

Watch the video again before cutting.  
Press all cottons before cutting.

Measure your printer accuracy with this 10 cm line.  
Remember to set your printer to "Actual" page.



**10 cm**

This pattern is for our Average Female Head Size which is 22.5 inches or 57.5 cm in circumference. A full pattern is available for a nominal fee. Check the links in the video description for more information.

Seam Allowance of 3/8" or 1 cm is built into the black outline of the pattern pieces. If you need a larger seam allowance of 1/2" or 13 mm, cut to the outside edge of the shadow.

Tip, print two copies and tape together the brim pieces at the center fold line to make a full brim pattern piece.
