and Ann
Eysenring**

"All of our farming is biodynamic and organic," says Alice Bamford as she walks around **One Gun Ranch**, her 25-acre home nestled in the Santa Monica Mountains that she shares with her partner, Ann Eysenring. Bamford is pointing out all that she and Eysenring grow (red cabbage, purple carrots, passion fruit, yellow turmeric, four types of basil...) and raise (sheep, goats, chickens...). The property—including a guesthouse, dressage arena, and Airstream trailer—isn't open to visitors, but the pair do have a Rolling Vintage Farmers Market (they advertise its whereabouts via social media), and local restaurants such as Café Habana, Nobu, and Soho House use One Gun Ranch's produce.

The women also curate the One Gun Ranch store on Malibu Pier. It stocks everything from Gladys Tamez Millinery hats and the clothing line of their friend (and Malibu resident) Laird Hamilton to their new book, *One Gun Ranch, Malibu: Biodynamic Recipes for Vibrant Living* (Regan Arts). 1gunranch.com
