When 'Exploring the Gospels', in order to interpret them correctly, the following principle applies:

You must use and interpret scripture according to its purpose.

The purpose of the gospel records, according to their writers, is to make manifest Yeshua the son of Abraham, the son David, the son of God, in order that in believing in him you may obtain life.

By making him manifest you announce the arrival of the King of Israel, by whom YeHoVaH's salvation appears to all men, to deliver Israel from the hand of their enemies and them that hate them, so they can serve YeHoVaH in righteousness, holiness and in peace.

Luke 1:67

67 And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied,
saying,

68 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his
people,

69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant
David;

70 As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the
world began:

71 That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate
us;

72 To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy
covenant;

73 The oath which he sware to our father Abraham,

74 That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our
enemies might serve him without fear,

75 In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.

The reason why Israel needs deliverance from their enemies, to this day, is because unlike their father Abraham, who's seed was promised the land because of his obedience, Israel disobeyed.

However, YeHoVaH always has a remnant.

So although Mary, Joseph, Zacharias, and Elizabeth were raised in biblical households and were vessels for the Holy Spirit, they were waiting on one to save them, and their nation from the hand of their enemies, because of the disobedience of their forefathers and those dwelling in the land.

The just live by faith, so a righteous remnant must resist being drawn away following the error of the unrighteous, lawless and faithless, leading you away from following Yeshua because of the environment you find yourself in.

Luke 2:1

1 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be taxed

(apographō ä-po-grä'-fō G583, to write off, copy (from some pattern), to enter in a register or records, spec. to enter in public records the names of men, their property and income, to enrol).

2 (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.)

3 And all went to be taxed (apographō ä-po-grä'-fō G583), every one into his own city.

4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

Although Abraham's seed, according to the flesh, were dwelling in the land, because they, being lead by the religious leaders, didn't do the works of Abraham, who obeyed, they were oppressed within it.

John 8:39

39 They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham...

44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

When you apply a filter to the scriptures, eisegete religiously or culturally, instead of obtaining the promises of Abraham, to inherit the land and through his seed all nations are blessed, you become along with the earth, smitten with a curse.

“Octavian ‘Augustus’ Caesar (63 BC – 14 AD) was Julius Caesar’s named successor and for all intents and purposes — though notably not in title — Rome’s first true Emperor. The son of Julius’ niece Atia, Augustus is recognised as the founder of the Roman Empire, which he ruled from 27 BC until death. Upon the assassination of Caesar in 43 BC, Octavian fought to avenge his great uncle and adoptive father’s death. He finally defeated Antony and Cleopatra in a civil war for control of all of Roman territory in 31 BC and adopted the name of Augustus.” <https://www.historyhit.com/who-was-emperor-augustus/>

Israel, while dwelling in their own land, the land of promise, were oppressed. Evidence of Caesar Augustus' dominion over Israel is evident in his command for all inhabitants of the world, including Israel, to be taxed, censored, in their own city.

Without an understanding of the process of the compilation of the scriptures, that gave us the Bible as we know it today, you can be misled into believing God was silent for 400 years between Malachi and Matthew - leaving you ill-informed as to how Rome came to rule over them.

However, if one understands the influence of the Latin Vulgate, which used the Septuagint as its base, then you will appreciate that the additional 14 books in the 1611 King James Bible can help to paint a picture as to how Israel became oppressed by their enemies once again.

Daniel 8:19

19 And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end shall be.

20 The ram which thou sawest having two horns are the kings of Media and Persia.

21 And the rough goat is the king of Grecia: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king.

1 Maccabees 1:10

10 And there came out of them a wicked root Antiochus surnamed Epiphanes, son of Antiochus the king, who had been an hostage at Rome, and he reigned in the hundred and thirty and seventh year of the kingdom of the Greeks.

11 In those days went there out of Israel wicked men, who persuaded many, saying, Let us go and make a covenant with the heathen that are round about us: for since we departed from them we have had much sorrow.

12 So this device pleased them well.

13 Then certain of the people were so forward herein, that they went to the king, who gave them licence to do after the ordinances of the heathen:

14 Whereupon they built a place of exercise at Jerusalem according to the customs of the heathen:

15 And made themselves uncircumcised, and forsook the holy covenant, and joined themselves to the heathen, and were sold to do mischief...

Don't despise being peculiar.

The world has mastered fulfilling the lusts of the flesh, when you're called to crucify it.

You invite the wrath that's stored up for the children of disobedience upon yourself when you mimic them.

Although Daniel was shown the Kingdoms of the earth that were to come, his book being compiled in the TaNaKh, Israel still invited the Greeks in.

The Greek empire eventually fell, but it wasn't until men who guarded the covenant, honoured the law of YeHoVaH and stood for righteousness that Israel defeated their enemies.

However, not learning from their mistake, Israel a generation later invites Rome into their affairs, once more leading to them being dominated by their enemies - accomplishing prophecy.

“It all began as a family quarrel sometime in the year 63 b.c.e. Two brothers from the Hasmonean dynasty, Hyrcanus and Aristobulus (they were descended from the great Macccebees) vied for the throne in Jerusalem. Their family had been the ones who had succeeded in ousting the abhorred Greeks from Israel some one hundred years before and they had established themselves as high priests, and kings of Israel in no uncertain terms.

For one hundred years the mighty Romans had been advancing eastward. In 67 B.C.E. General Pompey reached Syria and established it as a province for Rome. Cities were built to assure Rome's eternal presence in the area and Pompey settled for a time at least before he would assert his rights in Rome. One day he received two messages for help from Hyrcanus and Aristobulus. Neither one was ready to relinquish power and called on Rome to intervene. Pompey just happened to have some free time on his hands and was only too happy to come to their assistance. What should have been settled over the week-end turned into a five hundred year nightmare.

Inviting the Romans in to solve the problem was engaging an elephant to destroy a mouse. Like the man who came to dinner, the Romans considered the invitation permanent. Mighty Rome was not to be trifled with. It took its duty seriously. When it came to the aid of a smaller state, it formed an alliance that was irrevocable and any attempt to negate it was regarded as rebellion. Rome settled the dispute in favor of Hycarnus but he scarcely had time to thumb his nose at his brother than he realized that he had lost all power and that the noble Hasmonean Empire was at an end.

It was Rome's custom to place a friendly king on the throne of any country on their borders that they had no wish to govern. They called them "client Kings". Hycarnus was allowed to rule a small territory. He ruled only in name. The real power was in the hands of his minister Antipater, a man who had proved himself a friend to the Romans, and he would become the father of a man who would be an even greater friend, Herod the great..." – http://www.sbofmhk.org/eng/Research/Early_christianity/early_christianity_0001.html

Psalm 1:1

1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

Do as Zacharias, Elizabeth, Joseph and Mary did, be just, blameless so Father as the master orchestrator can work all things out for your good.

Luke 2:3

3 And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

5 To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

Micah 5:1

1 Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops: he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek.

2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

The earth is YeHoVaH's.

He is the master orchestrator and in the midst of a rebellious people, under the rule of Rome, Father can prompt an Emperor to command the world in order to accomplish his will.

Without this command to tax, censor the world, the scripture would not be fulfilled as to where Messiah would come from.
