Recommended Application

Make certain that your wood surface is free from all dirt, stains, oil, grease, grime, mildew, fungus or loose bark prior to stain application. Additionally, it is important that the porosity of your wood surface is consistent to ensure an even single coat application. UV Guard® II Wood Finish may be applied by brush, airless sprayer or pump sprayer. If spray application is used then back brushing is necessary. The first coat should be a heavy saturation coat of UV Guard® II Wood Finish followed by a final topcoat of UV Guard® Advance Clear Wood Finish. The second coat can be applied as a wet-on-wet application or a wet-ondry application. Each coat will be dry to the touch within 30 minutes to an hour and completely dry within 24 to 48 hours depending on the ambient temperature and the relative humidity. Both products used together offer the maximum amount of protection and durability. Maintenance

Once your finish starts to look dull then simply clean the surface and apply another coat of the clear finish. Expect to re-apply UV Guard® Advance Clear Wood Finish every 2 to 4 years on the southern exposure and every 3 to 5 years on the other sides of your structure. Please remember that the overall durability of your stain is dramatically affected by the preparation of your wood prior to staining and how good of a job you do during the stain application process. Back brushing your stain into the pores of your wood is a must.
