OUTREACH SKILLS PROGRAMME 2018

The **Outreach Skills Program** teaches adults from previously disadvantaged communities and marginalised groups to develop design and craft skills to enable them to create marketable products and generate an income.

Tuition, a transport stipend and materials are provided pro bono to learners.

The programme is for youth between the ages of 18 to 35 years.

The Outreach Skills Program very positively integrates learners from diverse communities, thus establishing commonalities and promoting understanding and interaction.

The Outreach Skills Program is a course that has been devised, maintained, promoted and organised solely by the concerned members of staff with financial assistance from the School and donor organizations.

OUTCOMES

The Outreach Skills Program is a modular year program of learning in design and craft skills. You will be able to create marketable products and to share these skills and to join other craft projects in your own communities or set up their own small micro businesses.

- 1. To provide you with basic skills to utilise art and craft tools.
- 2. To provide you with design skills and creative skills.
- 3. To provide you with the ability to add value to acquired skills.
- 4. To provide you with related skills with the object of furthering tertiary education.
- 5. To provide you with a possible life sustaining career.
- 6. To provide you with entrepreneurial skills

THE COURSE

You will achieve a practical body of knowledge with supporting theory. The course will enable you to share this knowledge with other learners in the community but also to generate an income. In addition, your creativity and design skills are stimulated with valuable life skills.

The course runs every Saturday morning and one Monday every month throughout the academic year.
