From a single vineyard. Fragrant black fruits, multi spices, licorice and a subnote of tar presage a totally distinguished and focused cool palate, cool in the sense of grapes that have been cool grown and picked at optimal ripeness, in turn reflected by the sheer intensity of the wine.

The grapes come from the large Langton Vineyard planted in the early '70s, and revered for the quality of its grapes. The wine is at once delicate yet intense, airy yet focused, citrusy yet minerally. These contradictions will all resolve themselves over the next 5-10+ years, richly rewarding patience.
