HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 2 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

Rated Best of the Best by Variety Cabernet Sauvignon.



Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon

Region: Margaret River

Block 2 has the oldest vines on the vineyard, reflected in the depth of varietal fruit aroma and the palate. It has been singularly well made, drawing out the full array of blackcurrant, bay leaf and black olive fruits. The texture, structure and balance rest on ripe tannins, making a complete wine.



HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 1 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018

Rated Best of the Best by Variety. Equal Top rated SSB Blend for 2021.



Variety: Semillon Sauvignon Blanc

Block 1 has some of the oldest semillon and sauvginon blanc vines on the property. It's rare to find such a combination of finesse, elegance, intensity and length. The barrel ferment element is of minor importance but does contribute to this special wine.

HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 6 CHARDONNAY 2018



Variety: Chardonnay

From the coolest block on the vineyard, free-run juice direct to French barrels (35% new), no mlf, no stirring, 11 months on lees. More restrained than most quality chardonnays from the Margaret River, Yarra Valley, etc. palate, and are sustained through the length of the wine.

HAY SHED HILL CHARDONNAY 2018



Variety: Chardonnay

Estate-grown. The bouquet is very pure, pointing to the restrain of the palate where white stone fruit, apple and grapefruit do the talking. It was barrel-fermented, which has left its imprint on both the bouquet and palate. The way the wine has developed to date makes me certain it will grow old with grace, a long way down the track. Great value.

Dry-grown estate vineyard, 10 day's open fermentation, press to French barriques, some new, for 18 months. Powerful, balanced wine, cabernet tannins a feature, adding to the present and future length. Bargain price.

A Bordeaux blend of cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, merlot, malbec and petit verdot; the name reflection the '70 Sussex Vale name change to Hay Shed Hill in '89 when Barry and Liz Morrison purchased, expanded and rehabilitated the vineyard. Matured for 18 months in French barriques it has excellent balance and length to its blackcurrant fruit flavours.



HAY SHED HILL SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON 2019



Variety: Sauvignon Blanc Semillon Region: Margaret River

Far more depth than many unoaked SBS blends. The fruit is rich and complex, lychee and guava held in control by grassy/citrus notes ex the semillon and good acidity. Has cellaring capacity if you want.



HAY SHED HILL CABERNET MERLOT 2017



Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot

This is a good Margaret River Bordeaux blend. It marries supple, rich blackcurrant fruit with tannins that are manifestly ripe. The overall balance and length are in good company with each other, the price excellent value.

HAY SHED HILL MALBEC 2017



Variety: Malbec

Region: Margaret River

From the Happs Vineyard at Karridale with a seldom used (in Australia) trellis system. Hand-picked, small open fermenters, matured for 12 months in French barriques (20% new). The colour is deep, and the wine full-bodied; a strong savoury shaft penetrating plummy fruit. One to cellar and spring a surprise 20 years down the track.
