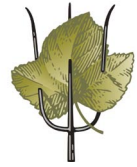

HAY SHED HILL CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2020

Included in Top Rated Cabernet Sauvignon

A classic high-quality Margaret River cabernet from an extremely good vintage, with more depth to rounded, fleshy fruit and quality oak than is usual with this wine. It's estate grown, and the vines decades old. It exudes cassis and has an excellent ripe tannin structure. by James Halliday



KERRIGAN + BERRY RIESLING 2022

The bouquet is that of a meadow of spring flowers crushed underfoot, with a sprig of lavender for good measure. The palate takes up the story, with juicy kaffir lime, lemon and crisp acidity all on the same page. This is riesling country. by James Halliday



KP NATURALLY TEMPRANILLO ROSÉ 2022

Included in Top Rated Rosés

You know, when you hand pick fruit, crush it and press it to old barrels allowing natural fermentation to do its thing, then bottle it unfined and unfiltered, guess what happens? All the good stuff is left in the wine. What a gorgeous drink. The palest copper blush, mildly cloudy of course, with heady aromas and flavours of squishy raspberries and spice, but it's the texture that tantalises. Creamy and smooth, savoury and light to the very end, finishing with a zap of acidity. KP, you've done well. By Jane Faulkner



HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 1 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC 2021

These estate dry-grown vines are amongst the oldest in Margaret River. This is a particularly attractive example of semillon/sauvignon blanc, with a layer of white peach and passionfruit joining the more usual lemon and snow pea. Subtle creamy oak nuances add to the length of the finish. By James Halliday

HAY SHED HILL MORRISON'S GIFT 2020



Estate-grown. A blend of Bordeaux's five varieties that offer a rare mix of juicy and dusty aromas and flavours. While only medium bodied, the palate and finish are very long, the aftertaste (and the price) mouth-watering, the tannins spicy.

HAY SHED HILL BLOCK 2 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2020

If the fabulous dark red hue or heady aromas don't make your heart flutter, check your pulse. Or taste this excellent wine. Full of violets, blackcurrant pastilles, mulberries and nori with the cedary/menthol oak certainly a player, adding fragrance and more shape to the full-bodied palate. While the flavours are rich and intense, this is smooth and plush with finely apportioned tannins.

KP NATURALLY PET NAT RIESLING 2022



I love the way Katie Priscilla (KP) Kerrigan is keeping her dad – renowned winemaker Michael Kerrigan – on his toes. So this is delicious. Yes, cloudy and straw-like with complex aromas and flavours with umami galore. Lots of good fizz and super dry and refreshing, the acidity is almost too much of a good thing, so do have an antipasto platter at hand. This is like lemonade for grownups. Love it. HAY SHED HILL SHIRAZ TEMPRANILLO 2020



Now aren't these two varieties good friends. Each brings their best to this savoury, juicy wine. Lovely plump and ripe fruit comes infused with red licorice, sarsaparilla and dried herbs. Fine grit to the tannins and succulence throughout the mid-weighted palate. A little ripper. By Jane Faulkner



PITCHFORK CABERNET MERLOT 2020



This is a good Margaret River Bordeaux blend. It marries supple, rich blackcurrant fruit with tannins that are manifestly ripe. The overall balance and length are in good company with each other, the price excellent value. by Jane Faulkner



HAY SHED HILL SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON 2022



Attractive florals and fresh, herby charm with citrus flavours that fire up the palate. Fine and long with lemony/saline freshness throughout. by Jane Faulkner



PITCHFORK PINK 2022



A spot-on rosé with its pink blush, delicate aromatics of florals and exotic spices. The palate is crisp, refreshing and lively with tangy, juicy, citrusy acidity throughout. Perfect on a summer's day. by Jane Faulkner



HAY SHED HILL CABERNET MERLOT 2020



As to be expected, plenty of blackberries, mulberries and raspberry leaf plus a handful of spices and river mint. Tannins are in check and it feels right to pour this now. by Jane Faulkner
