The Hay Shed Hill Block Series wines are made from small parcels of fruit from individual blocks on the vineyard to showcase the best of Hay Shed Hill. Planted in 1975 to Gin Gin (Mendoza) clone Chardonnay, Block 6 has a steep south-facing aspect thereby reducing the sunlight interception by the vines and creating a cool micro climate ideal for quality Chardonnay production. These dry grown vines produce tiny quantities of fruit with distinctive restrained minerally character.

Precisely balanced chardonnay off a single block on this established vineyard. It's from the Gin Gin clone, with the free-run juice fermented in a mix of French oaks, of which 35 per cent was new. There is a beautiful tactile purity here as a result of no malolactic fermentation. The lees influence is subtle but adds richness and complexity. Lovely mix of light butterscotch and meal.
