VINTAGE 2017

91 Points | Toni Paterson, The Real Review

Excellent colour with a dark plum-red hue. A warm and inviting aroma with sour cherry and redcurrant notes. The wine is medium-bodied and has pleasing middle-palate density. It's a serious, well-made wine with a classical red wine structure. Great value. Ranked #14 of 46 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon Blends from Australia.

VINTAGE 2016

92 Points | James Halliday January 2018

Estate-grown, matured in French barriques for 12 months. A very snappy wine given its provenance first up, and then in the mouth. It is no more than medium-bodied, but unrolls its flavours steadily and surely, first up cassis/blackcurrant, then tapenade and persistent but soft tannins. An open-ended drinking span.

Ticks all the boxes from the first whiff through to the finish and aftertaste; shows the effortless power that a medium-bodied wine can provide when varieties, place and winemaking are all in sync. 12 months in French oak simply serves to frame the luscious blackcurrant and redcurrant fruit flavours, savoury but fine tannins the mark of cabernet.

Pretty had to fault this as a \$20 value-for-money cabernet merlot blend. It delivers all you want at this price point with soft generous fruit flavours and good structure to give it direction to a long finish. Lovely medium-bodied short-term drinking wine.
