There's a lot to like here: dense raspberry fruit, firm yet fine tannins, good length of flavour. The whole thing packs a punch ... but then, it is from the radiant 2018 vintage. All things in place in this delicious, textbook grenache. Not boundary pushing, but modern and verging on glossy. The tannins and concentration of flavour say it may live a while yet.
