VINTAGE 2018

Mulberries and plums, soft and juicy, fleshy tannins and a roll of lavish sweet spice. Has the texture, almost of balloon skin, full of deep fruit character buoyant inside but tempered by bite and tension on the outside. Any way you approach it, it's great next oil and delivers a lot of 'Malbec-ness'.

Violets, dried roses, blueberries and red plums - oak is quiet, fruit allowed to shine. Juicy and lithe; more treble than bass. An easy drink.

Special Value for money rating

From the Happs Vineyard at Karridale with a seldom used (in Australia) trellis system. Hand-picked, small open fermenters, matured for 12 months in French barriques (20% new). The colour is deep, and the wine full-bodied; a strong savoury shaft penetrating plummy fruit. One to cellar and spring a surprise 20 years down the track.

VINTAGE 2016

94 Points | James Halliday Wine Companion 2020

Grown at Karridale. 20% new oak. It sits on the fuller side of medium weight, a satisfying place to be, and thanks to its chocolatey tones, graphite notes and flush of berried goodness it makes a serious case for itself. This is a handsome red wine. Leather, peppercorn and cedar wood characters sweep into frame as it breathes. Nicely done.

Hand-picked, cold-soaked, open-fermented with cultured yeast, 18 days on skins, matured in French barriques (20% new) for 12 months. Crimson-purple; a high quality medium to full-bodied malbec full of plum and black fruits, the texture complex and satisfying, the tannins perfectly balanced and integrated.
