Special Value Rosette

Attractive bouquet, showing sweet spice, bright red fruit, and an aromatic, almost floral lift. Just medium-bodied, the palate has a buoyant feel, the flavours not so deep, but juicy, fresh and lively. Gently persistent astringency gives shape and length to the finish, and the aftertaste of tangy red fruit lingers pleasantly.
