
Long Edge of Credit Card

Printable Guide Method (Ring match and/or measurer cut-

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

Print out this entire page with page scaling set to 100%. Match the long edge of your credit card to the line on the left side of the page.

If the credit card matches, your printed guide is correctly scaled.



001. Cut-Out Measuring Tool

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the measuring tool using the cut lines as a guide for your straight edge.
- 2. Cut a slit along the dotted line.
- 3. Slide the tail end of the tool into the slit so that the tool forms a circle. Loop it around the finger you want measured.
- 4. Carefully pull the tail end through the slit until the loop fits snugly around your finger.

Important tip: Pull as tight as you can! Since this measuring tool is made out of paper, you want to make sure that your finger is tightly wrapped to account for the flexibility of paper.

5. Read the number that matches right up against the slit. This is your ring size.

002. Ring comparison chart using a ring you own

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place a ring that you already own over the circles.
- 2. Match the inside of the ring to the circle nearest in size.

Important Tip: You want to find a circle that fits entirely inside your ring; a clue that you've found the right match is that you will see just a sliver of edge outside the black circle within your ring. If you see all black and no edge, it's likely your ring is covering part of the circle.

Important Tip: Place the page on a flat surface and view the chart from the top, at a straight angle.

3. The measurements shown refer to the size of the ring and to its corresponding inside diameter of the ring. If the ring falls between two sizes, select the larger size as your standard size (not the Ready-Made size - see more below).

Important Note: Consider the width of the ring you want to order. The wider the band, the tighter it may feel.

Style Sizing + Fit

Saturn Thin Ring, Satellite Ring, Unidentified Object Band, Jelly Ring	True to size; select your ring size
Cloned Object Band, Chunky Object Band	Ring widths are thicker; size up. If you are a half size, go up to the next whole size. For example, both sizes 5 and 5.5 select size 6.
Basic Object Band	Mostly true to size, but will be a little snug due to the wider ring width. If you are a half size, go up to the next whole size. If you want a looser fit, go up to the next whole size; if you want a tighter fit, select your usual size.
