

# Tokajicum Aszu 6 Puttonyos 2013

## Tasting Note

Amber-coloured with a bright golden hue. On the nose are alluring aromas of nectar and apricot fruit. Intense and flavourful, a sip of this Tokaji brings about all sorts of pleasure with deep fig notes, soft honey and a zippy apricot finish. Superb balance.

## Food Pairing Suggestions

Sticky toffee pudding, crème brûlée or Mountain gorgonzola blue cheese and water biscuits.

## Vineyard & Winemaking

Tokajicum describe 2013 as a 'near perfect' vintage. The grapes are grown in first-class vineyard sites, some of which are over 40 years' old, scattered over Tokaj. This allows for creative blending in the winery to achieve a top-quality style.

## Producer Profile: Tokajicum Borhaz

Once owned by Count Andrassy, this 20-hectare estate is in an iconic location with panoramic south-facing views of Tokaj's Kopasz Mountain, Tarcal. The winery makes a range of still dry wines but it has gained fame and attention for its sweet Tokaji.
