

Butterfly Release Instructions

1. Open the shipping box, locate the ice pack and check if it needs to be re-frozen.
2. If the ice packs need to be refrozen, remove them from the shipping box and place in the freezer. Put all the packing materials back the way they were.

DO NOT FREEZE THE BUTTERFLIES.

3. Continue to store the butterflies in a cool room at or below 74°F
4. Once the ice packs are refrozen, place them back in the shipping box with the butterflies, the same way it was when it arrived.
5. Check the ice packs again as needed and refreeze them if keeping for an extra day or if you are unable to keep them in a cool room. The butterflies should be kept cool and dormant until the day of the release.

IF YOU ARE DOING A MASS RELEASE:

The Day of the Release

1-2 hours prior to the release time, remove the butterflies from the original shipping container. Display them in a basket or transfer them to another release box or cage (see mass release instruction sheet). You may hear a bit of movement, do not be alarmed, they are living creatures. This is normal.

DO NOT PUT THE BUTTERFLIES IN THE FREEZER

DO NOT STORE IN THE REFRIGERATOR FOR MORE THAN 30 MINUTES

DO NOT APPLY DIRECT HEAT
