



HOW TO WRAP THE PERFECT GIFT - OUR FIVE STEP GUIDE

1. Ah tissue!

We think tissue paper is beautiful for gift wrapping. Use one layer of festive pattern then lay 2 or 3 layers of crisp white tissue paper on top. Fold the end under of the tissue paper to create a clean finish.





2. Stylish sticking

Stylish stickers rather than sellotape give a more finished look



3. Crease and cut

Make a mark in the tissue with your finger where the end of the box is and then cut the paper carefully along that crease.







4. It's all in the folding...

a. Fold the sides in creasing the corners to mould the gift









b. Fold over the ends to create a clean line and stylishly stick!

5. Give your gift a ailk finish We always wrap our gifts with silk

We always wrap our gifts with silk ribbon which gives a classic and stylish finish.

- a. Wrap the ribbon around the box 4-5 times so you get the perfect length. Start the ribbon over the longest side of the gift and where you want to have the bow (away from the folded side)
- b. Cross the ribbon over on the back at right angles to make a cross







5. Give your gift a pilk finish

c. Then turn the gift over and thread the ends of the two loose ribbon ends back underneath and through the taut ribbon, keeping hold close where the knot will be. This will prevent the ribbon slacking before you knot.

d. Tie it in a knot







e. And then tie a bow. Fold the ends and cut at an angle to finish it off.

Now, all you need to do is deliver with a smile
