



# Care & Maintenance

All Coco Flip products are designed to last a lifetime but they will need a little care and attention to make sure they can be enjoyed by generations to come.

---

## Environment and use

Considering the location of your products is essential to keep them looking their best. Exposure to sunlight, fluctuating temperatures, moisture and humidity can all affect the longevity of your products and should be avoided. Our furniture and lighting is designed for normal domestic use and should be used sensibly and well maintained to ensure that they last.

## Upholstery

- Our upholstered furniture is designed for regular indoor use.
- Carefully vacuum on a regular basis to remove dirt and dust before it settles into the upholstery.
- Spills and stains should be treated as soon as possible.
- For professional cleaning, see the specific details provided by Kvadrat or your custom fabric supplier.

## Fabric shades

- Wipe off dust with a dry, soft cloth.
- Remove any marks with a soft cloth lightly dampened in lukewarm water.
- Never use abrasive cloths or detergents containing abrasives or solvents.

## Powder-coated metals

- Wipe off dust regularly with a dry, soft cloth.
- Remove any marks with a soft cloth dampened in lukewarm water with a mild detergent.
- Never use abrasive cloths or detergents containing abrasives or solvents.

## Brass and copper

- Polishing our brass & copper products is not required as they are coated with a clear enamel to preserve the polished finish.
- Wipe off dust regularly with a dry, soft cloth.
- Remove any marks with a soft cloth dampened in lukewarm water with a mild detergent.
- Never use abrasive cloths or detergents containing abrasives or solvents.

## Timber

- Our timber is finished with Scandinavian oil and can be re-coated as required.
- Wipe off dust regularly with a dry, soft cloth to preserve the finish.
- Never use detergents, abrasives or solvents to clean oiled timber.
- Be especially careful to avoid contact with moisture, fluctuating temperatures and direct sunlight.

## Concrete composite table tops

- Our table tops are coated with a clear penetrating sealant to protect them against wear over time.
- Spills and stains should be treated as soon as possible to prevent penetration of the surface finish and staining.
- Remove any marks with a soft cloth dampened in lukewarm water with a mild detergent.
- Never use detergents containing abrasives or solvents.
