

Rinea Ghost Ink

Created specially for use with Rinea Foiled Paper

Our ghost ink is used for creating a reverse stamp – instead of leaving the stamped ink on the paper, it removes the color from our foiled paper and reveals the silver underneath for a magical effect. It works with any stamp – simple shapes and intricate designs.

Instructions

- 1. Apply ink thoroughly and stamp firmly on the foiled paper. Do not wiggle it while stamping (same as what you would do for any glossy paper). Pull stamp directly off to avoid smudging for a clear image.
- 2. Dry the stamped ink with a heat gun from approximately 6" away for about 5 seconds. Don't heat for too long or hold it too close to prevent the foiled paper from bubbling.
- 3. Wet a paper towel with 70% rubbing alcohol and wipe the stamped ink off the foiled paper to reveal the silver underneath and see the magic!

Tips

- It is best to try this on a scrap piece of foiled paper first to make sure it works right.
- The ghost effect is most visible on dark colors.
- Lighter colors create a subtle effect which can create a distressed or vintage appearance
- It does not work on Silver since there is no color to remove from it
